4th- Chapter 5—Electricity & Magnetism This week, we will learn about magnetism. We will investigate materials that are magnetic, and learn about electromagnets and generators. The test for this chapter will be after the Thanksgiving holiday.

5th- Chapter 4—Energy & Heat Test Monday, Nov. 12. We will spend the rest of the week reviewing *electrical energy* and *electricity* (from last year) according to the 5th grade TEKS. There will be no test over this material. We will begin Chapter 5 after the holiday.

6th- Chapter 4—Cells & Classification This week we will be reviewing characteristics of living things, cell parts, cell division, and classification of living things. Test for this chapter will be Thursday, Nov. 15.

7th- Chapter 5—The Cell Cycle and Protein Synthesis We will review cell division, asexual/sexual reproduction at the cellular level, and the function of DNA in protein synthesis. Test will be Thursday, Nov. 15.

8th- Chapter 4—Geology TEST moved to Tuesday, Nov 13. Then, **Chapter 5—The Changing Earth** We will compare and contrast the old-earth and young-earth viewpoints with respect to Earth's creation and changes to the earth since its creation. We will not test over this chapter.
