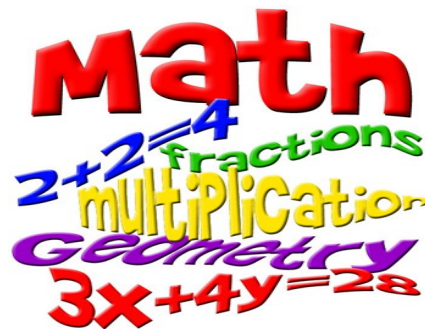


MATH NEWS CORNER

4th Grade Math: No test this week.

We are beginning a new chapter on Customary Measurement and Time. We will learn to use a ruler to measure and draw lines. We will also rename measurements, talk about length, distance, weight, capacity, and temperature. We will tell time, calculate elapsed time, read a calendar, and recognize roman numerals.

5th Grade Math: Test Thursday, March 21st.

We are busy solving Fractions— Adding and Subtracting. We are working with fractions with like and unlike denominators, as well as, mixed numbers. We are once again finding common denominators. *Please continue to work on basic math fact over Spring Break. Students are much more successful with fractions when they have a strong understanding of multiplication facts.

6th Grade Math: Test on Friday, March 22nd

This chapter is all about Expressions and Equations. We are simplifying expressions by adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing to solve equations and will learn to calculate distance, rate and time. The test we take over this section will be the last test for the current grading period.

7th & 8th Grade Math: Test on Friday, March 22nd.

We have been busy working on writing, simplifying and solving equations with variables on one side and both sides of the equation. We will gain a better understanding of Inequalities after break. We will solve and graph inequalities, as well as, apply inequalities. The test we take over this section will be the last test for the current grading period.
