**Math:** story problems; measurement; multiplication by 5



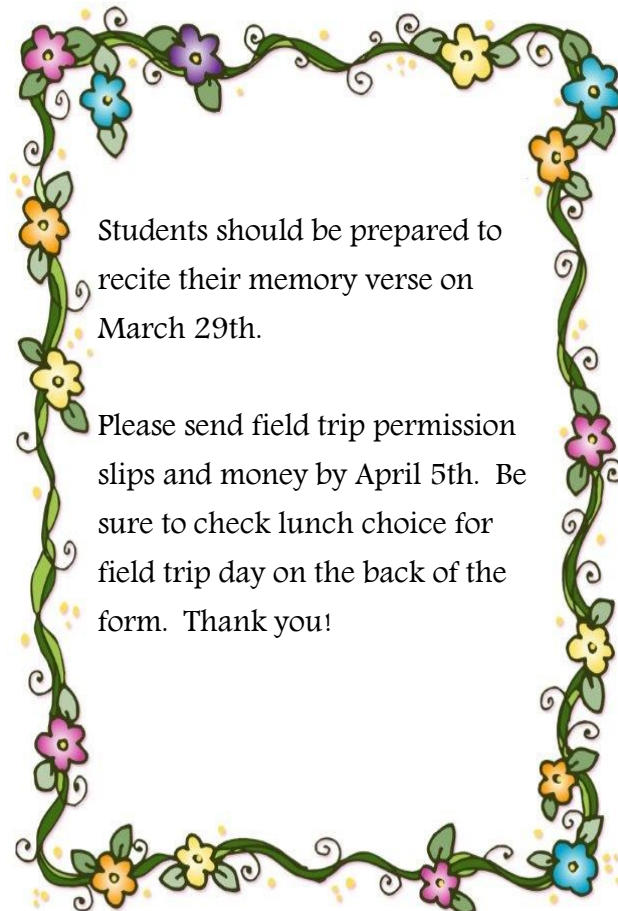
