### DATES AND HOURS OF OPERATION

MORLEY KIDS CAMP 2018 offers nine weeks of summer camp experience for children entering kindergarten through sixth grade (the program is recommended for children who are at least five years old). Children from any school in any town are eligible and welcome to attend Morley Kids Camp.

Campers are registered in weekly sessions. Camp sessions start on Tuesday, June 19 and end on August 17. MKC will be closed July 4th and from August 20-28.

Campers may also register for our popular DAY TRIPPER program. Instead of registering for the entire week (and if space is available after the weekly registration has taken place), children may participate in the Wednesday Field Trips only. The Day Tripper option is the <u>only</u> single-day option available. Day Tripper Registration begins <u>May 4</u>.

The camp day runs from 7:30 am until 5:45 pm, and children may arrive and depart at any point during that time period (except on field trip days, when they must arrive at least one-half hour before departure).

At the beginning of the child's camp session, parents will be given a schedule of activities and a Morley Kids Camp Handbook. Each week, parents will be notified of field trip plans as well as special events and activities.

#### **CAMP ACTIVITIES**

Weekly themes are reflected in activities, projects, and field trips. During the course of each week, we will play games, create arts and crafts projects, cook, play organized sports, enjoy gym and outdoor games, go to Fern Pool, take a field trip, participate in drama and music activities, and explore science and nature. Children will have daily opportunities to engage in group activities as well as independent projects.

On designated days each week, campers will take public transportation to and from Fernridge Park.

Once a week (Wednesday, unless otherwise noted), we will take a field trip. A list of the exciting trips we have planned is included in this packet. Field trip transportation is by school or coach bus.

To end each week, we will enjoy 'Wacky Water Fun' at Morley ~ sprinklers, water slides, and water games. On Friday afternoons, we will unwind after a busy week with an Awards Ceremony honoring each child's achievements, and a popcorn and movie party!

### DAILY CHECK LIST

Campers must bring:

- A nutritional lunch, including drink and utensils; we provide two snacks daily
- A bathing suit and towel for daily pool use or water play
- Sneakers and socks for gym games, Spectacular Sports, and playground use
- SPRAY, 'NO-RUB' sunscreen, to be left at camp
- On field trip days, campers are required to wear our tie-died camp shirt; the order form is included on the registration form
- Campers are encouraged to bring a labeled water bottle and a complete change of clothes

#### **CAMPING IN STYLE**

All campers are required to wear the **Morley Kids Camp shirt** on field trips. If your child does not have a shirt from last summer (that still fits!), you must order one and pay for it upon registration; please specify your child's size on the registration form. If your child is registered for at least **four weeks of camp**, you will receive a free shirt; please specify size.

During a non-field trip day, children should dress for comfort and for busy and active (and sometimes messy!) play.

# REGISTRATION of MEDC school-year enrollees and 2018 campers begins February 23, 2018

Families who are <u>currently enrolled</u> in MEDC's school-year program and families who enrolled <u>summer campers in 2018</u> may register upon receipt of these registration materials. Those families enjoy priority enrollment status until March 16<sup>th</sup>. Registration will be open to the community on March 16<sup>th</sup>. <u>Enrollment is limited and spaces will be filled on a first-come</u>, first-served basis.

In order to secure your child's space, please complete and return:

- REGISTRATION FORM (page 3 of this packet) and BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT POLICY (page 4 of this packet)
- If your child does NOT <u>currently</u> attend MEDC's school-year program, **a non-refundable \$30 REGISTRATION FEE** (per <u>family</u>) is required. Families whose children are currently enrolled in MEDC's before-and/or-after school program do not pay a registration fee; ALL OTHERS do.
- **DEPOSIT:** If your child will attend two weeks or more, your deposit equals two weeks' tuition, which will be applied to the <u>LAST TWO WEEKS</u> of attendance. If you are registering for only one week, or if you are registering two or more siblings, a one-week deposit per child is required.
- Payment for CAMP SHIRT if registered for fewer than 4 weeks

Upon receipt of the Registration Form and deposit, your child's enrollment will be confirmed by e-mail within two business days. At that time, you will also receive any paperwork that must be updated and on file before June 1.

## REGISTRATION FOR NEW FAMILIES begins March 16th

Registration for <u>NEW</u> campers begins on Friday, March 16<sup>th</sup>. You may register by mail or in person. If you register in person, please call 860-232-5336 to ensure that someone will be available to assist you.

In order to secure your child's space, please complete and return the following to Morley Extended Day Care, 77 Bretton Rd, West Hartford, CT 06119:

- REGISTRATION FORM (page 3 of this packet) and BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT POLICY (page 4 of this packet)
- A non-refundable \$30 REGISTRATION FEE per family
- DEPOSIT: If your child will attend two weeks or more, your deposit equals two weeks' tuition, which will be applied to the <u>LAST TWO WEEKS</u> of attendance. If you are registering for only one week, or if you are registering two or more siblings, a one-week deposit per child is required.
- Payment for CAMP SHIRT if registered for fewer than 4 weeks

Upon registration, your child's enrollment will be confirmed by e-mail and you will be provided with paperwork that must be on-file before June 1. You will also be asked to schedule a meeting with the Director of MEDC before the child starts camp, in order to review the child's records and MKC policies. Campers will not be permitted to attend until all paperwork is on file and a parent/guardian has met with the Director.

### **CHANGES IN ENROLLMENT**

Any changes in enrollment MUST be made in writing by **April 20**. If you withdraw your child before April 20, your deposit will be refunded. After April 20, you will be charged for any weeks reserved, unless we can fill your camper's space from our waiting list.

# WEEKLY TUITION FEES AND PAYMENT Early Bird fees until April 21 Day Tripper Fee Starts May 1<sup>st</sup>.

If you register **BEFORE APRIL 20**, the **EARLY BIRD TUITION FEE** is:

- > \$270 for Week 1-2
- > \$218 for Week 3 (July 2-6, CLOSED Wednesday, July 4)
- > \$270 for Weeks 4-9

If you register **AFTER APRIL 20**, the tuition fee will be:

- \$285 for Week 1-2
- \$ \$230 for Week 3 (July 2-6, CLOSED Wednesday, July 4)
- \* \$285 for Weeks 4-9

<u>The weekly tuition payment is due the FRIDAY PRIOR to the week of attendance</u>. Payment for Week 1 (June 19-22) is due no later than June 15. The tuition fee includes all activities, two daily snacks, field trip admission, pool admission, our Spectacular Sports program, and bus transportation to trip destinations and to the pool. The tuition fee does NOT include lunch or the camp shirt required for field trips; the shirt is free for campers who are registered for 4 or more weeks.

The **DAY TRIPPER** Registration Fee is \$60 per day. Day Tripper Registration begins May 1.

# Morley Extended Day Care / Morley Kids Camp Policy regarding BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS and MANAGEMENT / Statement of Understanding

MEDC's Mission Statement is to 'nurture individual children's growth in a safe, comfortable, and enriching environment' where they feel welcome and secure.

At Morley Kids Camp, we endeavor to meet the needs of different age groups and individual interests. We provide time, space, opportunity, supervision, and encouragement for children to participate in a wide variety of activities. We provide choices and opportunities for children to make decisions and accept consequences.

The Camp staff is committed to providing the safest environment for each child. As part of that commitment, we accept responsibility for setting limits and for monitoring children's behavior. We also acknowledge our responsibility to take appropriate action if inappropriate behaviors are exhibited by a child or by a group of children.

The following behaviors are not acceptable at Morley Kids Camp because they set bad examples, disrupt the activities of other children, or endanger children and/or staff:

- Bullying (physical, verbal, or emotional) or intimidating
- Using inappropriate physical contact (such as hitting, kicking, spitting, fighting, etc.)
- Swearing or using inappropriate language
- Disregard for the rules of MEDC
- Destruction of property

If, in the opinion of our staff, your child is unable to maintain appropriate behaviors and/or puts the wellbeing of other children or staff in jeopardy, or risks injury to himself/herself, the following actions will be taken:

- Staff will use respectful and positive discipline techniques to guide and redirect the child's behavior.
- If the misbehavior persists, the child will be removed from the activity and placed in supervised time-out. At the end of a specified amount of time (one minute for each year of age), the teacher and the child will briefly review the incident and will brainstorm alternative strategies in case the incident recurs.
- The parent or guardian will receive two copies of a 'Caring and Sharing' note describing the incident and the action taken. A parent/guardian is expected to sign and return one copy of the Caring and Sharing note.
- At the discretion of the Director, a meeting may be called between the child, the parents/guardians, and the Director. Solutions to behavioral problems will be discussed and may include a Behavior Modification Plan.
- In cases of severe or dangerous misbehavior, a parent or guardian will be called and asked to pick up the child within one hour. The child will not be permitted to return to Morley Kids Camp unless and until all parties have met to determine whether the structure of our program is suitable for the child. The child might be suspended for a period of two or more days. If it is decided that the child may continue attending Camp, a behavior plan will be implemented to encourage positive behaviors and the child will be placed on probation.
- If another incident occurs after the above-listed measures have been taken, <u>OR</u> if misbehavior is persistent or severe (such as aggressive, destructive, or anti-social displays), <u>OR</u> if the behavior (even if not persistent) is, in the judgment of the MEDC Director and staff, dangerous to the child or others in the program, the child may be permanently dismissed from Morley Kids Camp. A child who is permanently dismissed is not eligible for reinstatement.

The Morley Kids Camp staff will strive to create the best possible environment for your child to be successful in our program.
