The Community Benefit Fund of the Hancock County Commissioners has granted Families First Community Center \$25,000! With this donation, needed funding is now complete for the renovations and construction of the FFCC Home on North Street in Ellsworth!

The Hancock County Commissioners on February 21 distributed \$100,000 worth of Community Benefit Funds that were paid to the county by area wind farms!

The \$100,000 total was shared between area nonprofits that benefit Hancock County residents.
