Application due by January 1, and to be announced at the following annual year end banquet

An official transcript from high school or college from last semester (with at least 2.9 GPA)

Provide a letter(s) of recommendation(s) from a teacher, employer, coach, clergy, etc. NOT family or friend

One page resume, double spaced detailing your activities with SSHC and your activity with their community, also any awards received academic or other achievement awards.

Must have competed in one (1) or more of SSHC horse shows

Scholarship awarded after one completed semester and an official current transcript from the college (with at least a 2.9 GPA) is forwarded to the scholarship committee

Applicant must submit a color or black/white photograph head shot with application.
