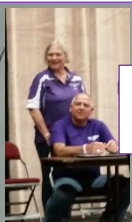

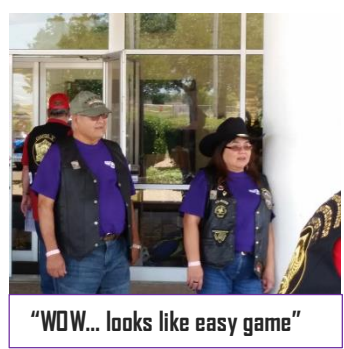

Preparation

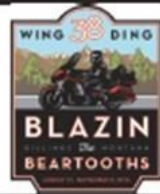
BEAT EGG WHITES UNTILL STIFF AND MIX ALL TOGHTER
