Look, linger and shop in the premier showcase for artists working in a variety of media. The shop is creamed floor to ceiling with beautiful examples of jewelry, pottery, paintings, drawings, photography, woodcrafts, children's toys, glass and other highly desirable, and reasonably priced, products from local artists, artisans and writers. You can even select from seasonal decorations. Be sure to also stop by Leon Thomas Treasures at the Hometown Exchange and The Overland Gallery to shop more unique creations by local artist.



Located in Eastern North Carolina, the Kinston Community Council for the Arts is a state-of-the-art 30,000 square foot center that is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Visual art occupies one-third of the space, with exhibits changing every six to eight weeks. As many as 300 works by up to 200 local, regional, national and international artists are on display at any given time. A large, detailed model train display is part of the permanent exhibit, and runs from 10 a. m. - 2 p. m. every first and fourth Saturday of the month.
