Whether painting the people of pastoral settings or urban locales, Kim creates an intimacy of colors, framing each scene with dimension and physicality. His work has been featured in *Figure Drawing Workshop* by Carole Katchen, as well as in such magazines as *SOUTHWEST ART*, *AMERICAN ARTIST*, and *THE ARTIST'S MAGAZINE*.

Kim is the recipient of numerous awards including the Allied Artists of America's Gold Medal of Honor, the William Meyerowitz Memorial Award for an American Scene, and both the Certificate of Merit and the Joseph Hartley Memorial Award at Salmagundi Club exhibitions. His work has been exhibited throughout the country, in private and public collections. When Kim and his artist wife, Andi, are not traveling the globe painting, they make their home in Colorado.
