CALLING ALL ARTISTS

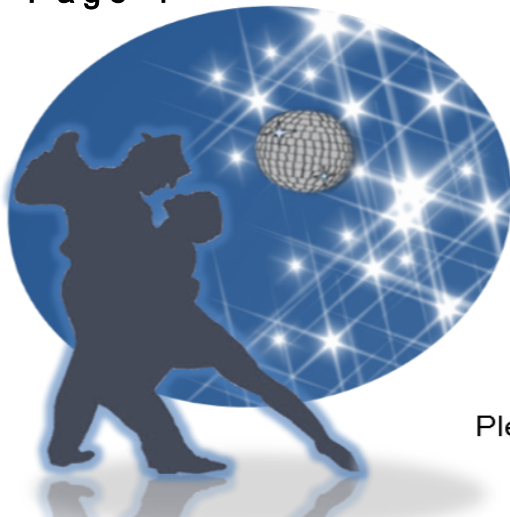
