

PLEIN AIR PAINT OUT — Wednesday, May 3, through Saturday, May 6

Juried exhibition and show. Judge for this year's event TBA. All participating artists must have their canvases stamped at the Arts Center. Registration fee per participant is \$30 for four (4) days, if registered on or before April 8, 2017, then \$35 for four (4) days, or \$10 per day. Artists registered to paint two (2) or more days receive a free 'Que the Arts party ticket.

- ▶ **Wednesday, May 3, 9:00 a.m.** — Meet at the Arts Center, 400 North Queen Street, for refreshments and registration. All panels will be stamped at this time. Each registrant will receive a welcome packet, which will include an area map. Artists registered to paint two (2) or more days will receive a free admission ticket (\$35 value) to 'Que the Arts (formerly called Evening with the Stars), the Arts Council's sponsored cocktail party, art show and sale. This event is scheduled for Wednesday, May 3, from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., at the Mother Earth Motor Lodge, 501 N. Heritage Street in Kinston. The rain date for this event will be Thursday, May 4, same time and location.
- ▶ **Thursday, May 4, 9:00 a.m.** — Registration at Arts Center for new arrivals and canvases stamped; artists free to paint.
- ▶ **Friday, May 5, 9:00 a.m.** — Registration at the Arts Center for new arrivals and canvases stamped; artists free to paint
- ▶ **Saturday, May 6 —**
 - 9:00 am — Artists free to paint
 - 3:00 pm — Artists submit work to the Arts Center; up to three (3) marked canvas painting may be entered for judging.
 - 4:00 pm — Artists return to Arts Center for Juror's commentary, awards, and refreshments. **Public is welcome and encouraged to attend.** Artists may enter more than three (3) plein air paintings in the wet paint sale. A commission will be charged on all works. Art works entered will be on display and for sale at the Arts Center.
