HAMPTON GALLERY – SALUTE! TRIBUTE TO AMERICA'S VETERANS –

Salute! A Tribute to America's Veterans art exhibit for 2017 is a collection of American vintage war propaganda posters used during World War I and World War II. These posters were designed to give Americans a positive outlook and sense of patriotism. Among the American artists and illustrators represented are James Montgomery Flagg, Howard Christy, and Jes Schaikjer. Also on display is a reproduction of the Four Freedoms Norman Rockwell painted in 1943, which rounds off the Salute theme this year: "One Nation Under God, A Nation United". 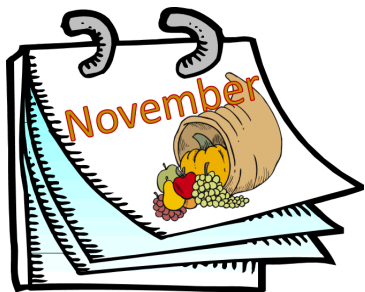

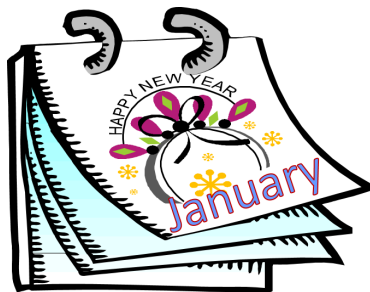
