37th Annual CCA National Competitive Exhibition — February 15, 2018 – March 31, 2018

RULES AND CONDITIONS: Competition is open to all U.S. artists, 18 years and older. All work must be original and executed within the past two years. Works previously shown by the Community Council for the Arts (CCA) Competition are **NOT** eligible. We will not accept video or installation art work. NO REPRODUCTIONS. NO GICLEES.

SIZE LIMITATIONS: No work can exceed nine feet (9') in any direction or weigh over 250 lbs. All works must be suitable for display. 2-D works must be hang-ready. Works that do not meet these criteria will not be displayed and the artist will be contacted to retrieve the work. Work that is deemed unsafe or overly fragile will not be accepted.

OPTION 1: DIGITAL ENTRIES

Each artist may submit:

- Up to 3 entries (2 or 3 images per entry)
- Digital images must be unaltered and in ipeg format and emailed to slandis@kinstoncca.com.
- Each image must be clearly labeled with artist name, title of work, dimensions and media. Mark the top front of the image with corresponding entry number.
- Email your images and entry information to slandis@kinstoncca.com and remit your \$30 entry fee on our website at www.kinstoncca.com.
- Digital entries must be time-stamped no later than **Friday**, **January 19**, **2018**. Entries time-stamped after the deadline will not be accepted.

RECEIPT OF WORKS: Accepted entries must arrive at the CCA by 1:00 p.m. on **Saturday, February 3, 2018.** Submitted, but unaccepted works, are eligible for exhibition and must be received at the CCA by 1:00 p.m. on **Saturday, February 3, 2018.** Please ship or hand-deliver to: CCA National Competitive Exhibition, 400 N. Queen Street, Kinston, NC 28501. Each piece must be labeled with the provided labels, found on the bottom of the next page. Artist must provide return shipping and proper crating materials for return of shipped work.

OPTION 2: HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted on the following dates:

Thursday, February 1, 2018 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. **Friday, February 2, 2018** 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Saturday, February 3, 2018 10:00 a.m. – **NO LATER THAN** 1:30 p.m.

LOCATION: The Arts Center, 400 N. Queen Street, Kinston, NC 28501; Works must be delivered during designated hours and dates.

ENTRY FEES: A non-refundable fee of \$30 enables the artist to submit up to three (3) entries total. Cash is preferred if hand-delivering entries. Online payments are accepted on our website, or make check/money order payable to: **CCA**. **Note:** if your check is returned, a \$25 processing fee will apply.

EXHIBITION DATES: All accepted works will be displayed in the First Floor Main Gallery (Hampton Gallery) and all unaccepted works will be displayed in the Second Floor Galleries.

PICK UP: Pick up work the week of April 3, 2018. (Tuesday, April 3, 2018 – Friday, April 6, 2018, 10:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m., or Saturday, April 7, 2018, 10:00 a.m.-NO LATER THAN 1:30 p.m.) ALL work for the show must be picked up NO LATER THAN Saturday, April 7, 2018, 1:30 p.m. Note: Work not picked up within fourteen (14) days of the close of the exhibition will become property of CCA.

AWARDS: Four (4) Cash Place Awards (\$1,000—Best in Show/ Purchase Award *To be added to the CCA's Permanent Collection; \$500—First Place; \$250—Second Place; \$100—Third Place) and five (5) Non-cash Merit Awards. Works priced \$1,000.01 and higher will not be considered for the Best in Show Award. Awards will be chosen from the physical works. All artworks which receive cash awards are eligible for sale EXCEPT Best in Show Award, which is a purchase award only. Artworks marked "not for sale" are ineligible for Best in Show Award consideration. Awards will be posted on our website www.kinstoncca.com Friday, February 16, 2018. Reception will be held Thursday, February 15, 2018, 5:30 p.m.-7:30 p.m.

SALES: The sale of all work is encouraged. A 35% commission will be imposed on all works sold during the exhibition, with the exception of the Best in Show Award.

LIABILITY: Works are insured by a blanket policy during the period of the exhibition. CCA is not responsible for work damaged in transit. Works will be examined for damage at time of delivery.

Materials for the class:

- Newspaper sketch pad (18" x 24") Newspaper pads are much cheaper than other types and more useable for learning to draw. We'll use a lot of paper. Please no pad smaller.
- Drawing pencils #2B, 4B, 6B only, one each if possible.
- Small artist pen such as Pigma Micron, Faber Castell, or Faber Castell. These are black permanent drawing pens, NOT permanent markers. Sizes # 0.5 or 0.8 mm. At most internet art supply or Hobby
- Kneaded eraser (gray moldable soft eraser).
- Drawing shield. Staples or art stores. Small metal drawing aid.
- Book: "Perspective" by William F. Powell. Paperback from Amazon is less than \$5. Including S&H and there are plenty of available ones at that price.
- Charcoal Sticks or pencils, soft or medium, NO hard sticks or pencils.
- Straight edge, such as a 15" ruler, or 24" no longer.
