NOV 5/MON-DEPART ORLANDO. Private coach transfer from parish to Orlando Airport.

NOV 6/TUE—ARRIVE AMMAN, JORDAN. On arrival, meet your guide and driver and depart north to the ruins of the once great Roman city of Jerash. Visit Maximus Cardo, the colonnade street flanked by temples, churches, theaters and endless mosaics. Transfer to Amman and check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. NOV 7/WED—AMMAN/MOUNT NEBO/PETRA. Morning visit to Bethany Beyond the Jordan, a fabulous and historic site of Jesus' Baptism. Then depart to Madaba, the city of mosaics with it's many Christian churches. See the famous mosaic map which floors the Greek Orthodox Church of St. George and is the oldest map in the world depicting the Holy Land. After, ascend Mount Nebo, the mountaintop memorial of Moses with captivating views of the Jordan Valley. Continue on via the Desert Road to the ancient rock fortress of Petra, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the new Seven Wonders of the World. Check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D) PETRA GUEST HOUSE or similar www.guesthouse-petra.com

NOV 8/THU—PETRA/AMMAN. Today, enjoy a morning walking tour through the "Siq", a long winding fissure between two walls of overhanging cliffs to the Treasury, the Street of Facades, the Court House and the Amphitheater. Enjoy some free time in the afternoon to explore this magnificent archeological site on your own. Transfer back to Amman and check-in to your hotel for overnight. (B,D)

NOV 9/FRI—AMMAN/JERUSALEM. After breakfast, enjoy a guided city tour of Amman. See the ancient ruins of Amman Citadel and see the city's stellar Roman amphitheater, a 6,000-seater stadium from the 2nd century. After, we will cross the Jordanian/Israeli border at the Allenby Bridge and continue through the wilderness of Judea up to the city of Jerusalem. NOV 10/SAT-JERUSALEM (BETHLEHEM). In the morning, visit Bethlehem. See Nativity Basilica, St. Catherine Church and Shepherds' Field. In the afternoon, take an excursion to Ein Karem, birthplace of St. John the Baptist and site of the Visitation. (B,D)

NOV 11/SUN-JERUSALEM. Drive to the Mount of Olives for an outstanding view of the city and surrounding area. Visit the Place of the Ascension, the Church of Pater Noster, and Dominus Flevit. Visit the tomb of the Virgin (the Church of the Assumption), Garden of Gethsemane, and the Church of All Nations. Continue to Mount Zion: the Church of St. Peter Gallicantu, King's David's Tomb, and the Cenacle (Place of the Last Supper) and Dormition Abbey. (B,D)

NOV 12/MON—JERUSALEM. Visit the Western Wall and Temple Mount. Visit the Church of St. Anne, the Pool of Bethesda and the Sisters of Sion to see the excavations of the pavement "Lithostrotos". Make the Way of the Cross, along the Via Dolorosa to Holy Sepulchre Basilica, site of Calvary and the Tomb. In the afternoon, visit Emmaus where the Risen Lord was recognized in the breaking of the Bread. (B,D)

NOV 13/TUE—JERUSALEM/TIBERIAS. Depart Jerusalem and travel via Jericho, the oldest inhabited city on earth. Arrive for lunch on your own in Galilee, center of Jesus' ministry. Ascend Mount Tabor, where Christ's Transfiguration is commemorated. Check-in to your hotel near the shores of the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight. NOV 14/WED-GALILEE. Sail across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, center of Jesus' ministry, today containing the ruins of an ancient synagogue, Byzantine chapel and St. Peter's house. Stop at Tabgha, site of the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes. Next ascend the Mount of Beatitudes to remember Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. (B,D)

NOV 15/THU-TIBERIAS/NAZARETH/TEL AVIV. In the morning stop at Cana, site of Jesus first miracle. Next, stop in Nazareth for lunch on your own and to visit Annunciation Basilica, where the Word of God became Flesh! Visit St. Joseph Church, Mary's Well, the synagogue and the town. Continue to Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Haifa. Enjoy a festive farewell early dinner at a local restaurant, then continue southward along the Mediterranean coast to your hotel in Tel Aviv for overnight.
