Living the Paschal Mystery

"Today's passage gives us a rather unique perspective on the identity of Jesus vis-à-vis his contemporaries. Often we are so imbued with stories from other gospels and preaching from years of attending Mass, that it can be challenging to hear a gospel story on its own terms, unencumbered by other material. But today's gospel reminds us that Jesus did not have it easy. Are we expecting the same? Today self-righteous Christians may think they are persecuted for their faith when in fact they might simply be obnoxious. Jesus was misunderstood not because of obnoxious behavior, aloofness, or one-upmanship, but because he enjoyed the company of "sinners." He ate with those who were considered of ill repute. He engaged those who were said to be with demons. He did not fast but enjoyed great dinner parties. His behavior embarrassed his family and those who preferred cultural norms that kept certain people on the margins. It's on this to admire Jesus. It's quite another to act as he did. Many of us are admirers of Jesus. But do I act as he did? Am I willing to face embarrassment to do what he did?"

"El pasaje de hoy nos da una perspectiva más bien única sobre la identidad de Jesús vis-à-vis a sus contemporáneos. Pero el evangelio de hoy nos recuerda que Jesús no lo tuvo fácil. ¿Estamos esperando lo mismo? Hoy en día, los cristianos que creen en sí mismos pueden pensar que son perseguidos por su fe cuando, de hecho, podrían ser simplemente detestables. Jesús fue malentendido no por su comportamiento desagradable, su actitud distante o su superioridad, sino porque disfrutaba de la compañía de los "pecadores". Comí con los que eran considerados de mala reputación. Muchos de nosotros somos admiradores de Jesús. Pero, ¿Yo actué como Él lo hizo? ¿Estoy dispuesto a enfrentar la vergüenza de hacer lo que hizo? dos buenas preguntas para reflexionar durante la semana. Dios los bendiga"
