June 24, 2018 - Nativity of St John the Baptist

Focusing on today's Gospel

Luke 1:57-66, 80

"When their son is born, Zechariah is asked what he wishes to name his newborn, Zachariah writes on a tablet, "John is his name." Zachariah now understands what God has asked him and Elizabeth to do and resolves to accept that role. Zachariah's speech returns and his first words are a beautiful canticle praising God's goodness and prophesying the wonderful things that his son John would accomplish (the *Benedictus* hymn, which is omitted from today's reading).

Throughout Luke's gospel, the Holy Spirit is the agent of transformation and change—God is both the story and the storyteller. Through the grace of the Spirit, John goes on to realize his role in the story: to prepare a "highway" for the Lord's coming and to point out his presence in our midst."

"Cuando nacio su hijo, le pregunta a Zachariah, por que nombre quieres llamar a tu recién nacido? Zachariah escribe en una tableta," Juan es su nombre ". El discurso de Zacarías regresa y sus primeras palabras son un hermoso cántico alabando la bondad de Dios y profetizando las cosas maravillosas que su hijo Juan lograría (el himno Benedictus, que se omite en la lectura de hoy). A lo largo del evangelio de Lucas, el Espíritu Santo es el agente de transformación y cambios: Dios es la historia y el narrador. A través de la gracia del Espíritu Santo, Juan se da cuenta de su papel en la historia: preparar un "camino" para la venida del Señor y señalar su presencia en medio de nosotros ".
