Focusing the Gospel

Mark 6:7-13

"In today's gospel, the Twelve are sent out by Jesus to preach repentance and minister to the sick and those possessed by demons. These unlikely candidates for such a task are carefully prepared and taught by Jesus for this moment. They undertake their first preaching and healing tour, depending only on God for their inspiration and on the charity of others for their needs (remember that hospitality was considered a sacred responsibility in the East it was not up to the stranger to seek hospitality but up to the prospective host to offer it). Jesus warns them to be prepared for the same rejection he has experienced from those they seek to serve."

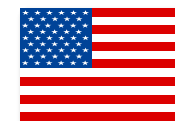

Planning and Capital Improvements Information

As some of you know, the Rectory roof suffered some shingle tab loss and ridge cap damage from Hurricane Irma, tabs and ridge caps were replaced and there was no evidence of water penetration into the building. Upon close examination, it was determined that the shingles were hard and brittle (20 plus years old). Five requests for bids were sent out and a selection of a roofer to provide a metal roof consistent with our desire, and complying with all applicable Diocesan and Putnam County Building requirements was made. The cost of this Capital Project is \$12,600.00 and has been approved by our Pastor and the Diocese.
