Focusing the Gospel - *John 6:41-51*

"From time immemorial, bread has been the staff of life, the basic and central food in many diets. To the "murmuring" Jews ("murmuring" as their ancestors did in the desert), Jesus tries to help them see the deeper meaning of his claim to be "the bread that came down from heaven." Christ is the bread of heaven that transcends this experience of life to the life of God.

The critical verb in today's gospel is "believe." We need to trust that God provides for and sustains our faith in his gift of Jesus, the Bread of Life, in the same way that Old Testament wisdom nourished the discerning seeker of God."
