Oct 7, 2018 - Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Focusing the Gospel - Mark 10:2-16

"The question of divorce was among the most divisive issues in Jewish society. The book of Deuteronomy stipulated that a husband could divorce his wife for "something indecent" (Psalm 24:1 NABRE). Interpretations of exactly what constituted "something indecent" varied greatly, ranging from adultery to accidentally burning a meal. Further, the wife was regarded under the law as the husband's chattel, with neither a legal right to protection nor recourse to seeking a divorce on her own. In biblical times, marriages were arranged rather than the product of romantic love. Marriages were often arranged in the husband's favor; the husband could divorce his for almost any reason, and the woman was treated (according to the law) as little better than property. Divorce then, was easy to obtain among the male among the male Jews of Jesus' time.

In today's gospel, Jesus cites the Genesis account of the creation of man and woman (the first reading) to emphasize that husband and wife are equal partners in the covenant of marriage ("the two shall become one flesh"). The language of Genesis indicates that the Creator intends for the marriage union to possess the same special nature as God's covenant with Israel. As authoritative teacher of Torah (Law), Jesus cites Genesis in making an absolute prohibition of divorce, something allowed by the law (in Deuteronomy). This kind of appeal to his own personal authority in matters of Mosaic law would have been frustrating to Jewish authorities. It is likely this kind of perceived arrogance led these same authorities to seek an end to the Galilean upstart.

Enfocando el Evangelio - Marcos 10: 2-16

"La cuestión del divorcio fue una de las cuestiones más divisivas en la sociedad judía. El libro de Deuteronomio estipulaba que un esposo podía divorciarse de su esposa por "algo indecente" (Salma 24: 1 NABRE). Las interpretaciones de lo que constituía exactamente "algo indecente" variaban enormemente, desde el adulterio hasta la quema accidental de una comida. Además, la esposa era considerada por la ley como el bien del marido, sin derecho legal a la protección ni a recurrir a la búsqueda del divorcio por su cuenta. En tiempos bíblicos, los matrimonios se arreglaban más que el producto del amor romántico. Los matrimonios a menudo se arreglaban a favor del marido; el marido pudo divorciarse de él por casi cualquier motivo, y la mujer fue tratada (según la ley) como algo mejor que la propiedad. Entonces, el divorcio era fácil de obtener entre los varones de los judíos varones de la época de Jesús.

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús cita el relato del Génesis de la creación del hombre y la mujer (la primera lectura) para enfatizar que el esposo y la esposa son socios iguales en el pacto del matrimonio ("los dos serán una sola carne"). El lenguaje de Génesis indica que el Creador pretende que la unión matrimonial posea la misma naturaleza especial que el pacto de Dios con Israel. Como maestro autorizado de la Torá (Ley), Jesús cita a Génesis al hacer una prohibición absoluta del divorcio, algo permitido por la ley (en Deuteronomio). Este tipo de apelación a su propia autoridad personal en asuntos de la ley mosaica habría sido frustrante para las autoridades judías. Es probable que este tipo de arrogancia percibida haya llevado a estas mismas autoridades a buscar un fin al advenedizo galileo.
