Did You Know? ¿Sabías?

Only priests are ministers of the Anointing of the Sick. It is a communal and liturgical celebration whether it takes place in a home, hospital or church. It is very fitting that it be celebrated within the Eucharist, if possible. The Sacrament is not only for those at the point of death, but rather given in the case of serious illness or infirmity. It can be received more than once. It is the duty of pastors to instruct the faithful on the benefits of this sacrament. (CCC # 1514 – 1516)

Ask Harry
