Focusing the Gospel

Key words and phrases: This is my body, which will be given for you; / do this in memory of me.

To the point: Before the pain and horror of Good Friday, Jesus gives his disciples the key to understand what will happen to him when he celebrates the Passover with them for one last time. Though it will take on the guise of a terrible act of violence, the crucifixion will be a gift of Jesus in his totality for the salvation of the world. It is the physical enacting of Jesus' words over the bread and wine, "This is my body; [this is my blood,] which will be given for you." As we read the passion today let us remember the mystery we are celebrating. Jesus died, but that is not the end of the story. The sorrow of Palm Sunday leads to the overflowing joy of Easter.

Palabras y frases clave: Este es mi cuerpo, que se te dará; Hago esto en memoria mía.

Al punto: ante el dolor y el horror del Viernes Santo, Jesús les da a sus discípulos la clave para entender qué le sucederá cuando celebre la Pascua con ellos por última vez. Aunque tomará la apariencia de un terrible acto de violencia, la crucifixión será un regalo de Jesús en su totalidad para la salvación del mundo. Christian Formation

Palm Sunday falls on the Sunday before [Easter](#). The feast commemorates Jesus' [triumphal entry into Jerusalem](#), an event mentioned in each of the four [canonical Gospels](#).

In most liturgical churches Palm Sunday is celebrated by the blessing and distribution of Palm branches or the branches of other native trees representing the palm branches the crowd scattered in front of Jesus as he rode into [Jerusalem](#). Entering the city on a donkey symbolizes arrival in peace rather than as a war-waging king arriving on a horse. The difficulty of procuring [palms](#) in unfavorable climates led to their substitution with branches of native trees, including [box](#), [olive](#), [willow](#), and [yew](#). The Sunday was often named after these substitute trees, as in **Yew Sunday**, or by the general term **Branch Sunday**.

Domingo de Ramos

El Domingo de Ramos cae el Domingo antes del Domingo de resurreccion (La Pascua). La fiesta conmemora la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén, ES un evento mencionado en cada uno de los cuatro evangelios canonicos.

En la mayoría de las iglesias la liturgia del Domingo de Ramos se celebra con la bendición y la distribución de las ramas de palmeras o las ramas de otros árboles nativos que representan las ramas de palmeras que la multitud dispersó frente a Jesús mientras cabalgaba a Jerusalén. Entrar a la ciudad en un burro simboliza la llegada en paz en lugar de un rey guerrero que llega a caballo. La dificultad de obtener palmas en climas desfavorables condujo a su sustitución por ramas de árboles nativos, que incluyen el olivo, el sauce y el tejo. El domingo se nombró después de estos árboles sustitutos, con el término general Domingo de ramos
