CHRISTIAN FORMATION

Brief Overview of the RICA

RICA is the normative process in the U.S. wherein un-catechized children over the age of reason (7-8) and adults are fully received into the Church. (RCIA forward viii-xi)

RICA consists of 3 types of people:

- o Catechumens: Un -baptized and no formation
- o Candidates: Baptized in an acceptable form in another faith tradition
- o Candidates: Baptized Catholic: to confirm these candidates, a delegation from Bishop is needed.

BREVE RESUMEN DEL RICA

RICA es el proceso normativo de los Estados Unidos en donde los niños no categuizados mayores de la edad de la razón (7-8) y los adultos son totalmente recibidos en la Iglesia.

RICA se compone de 3 tipos de personas:

- o Catecúmenos: No-bautizados y ninguna formación
- o Candidatos: Bautizado en una forma aceptable/ o en otra tradición de fe.
- o Candidatos Bautizados católicos: Estos candidates son para confirmer, pero necesitan una delegación del Obispo.
