

The running theme of this musical stage play was as men there are many pressures from society, their friends and families place on them. It was about the weight of the world on their shoulders and how they constantly playing the role of the strong man; the rock everyone can count on. This play pointed out the unrealistic



Fred Hammond dealt with incarceration and release also. There was a call for the need to support our men, because they are fighting everyday to show their worth as a "man" to the world and their significant others.

In May of this year, a 23 year old cousin ended her life. It was shocking and devastating for the family, especially her mother who was bedridden and only 45 years old. Her mom was heartbroken about her untimely death, and soon passed away this month of June from complications of a long illness. I shared my story and talked about this issue of Suicide on the Triumphant In Life Show (TIL Show)™, June 12, 2018 and June 26, 2018 with Dr. Robert Williams, Jr., Clinical Psychologist in private practice, located in California. Dr. Williams, Jr.'s interview is posted under the Announcement Section of the Triumphant In Life Show (click the black bar to listen), with links to help people who feel suicidal and in despair. It is my hope that whoever sees this information and listens to the show will save their life or others who may be in crisis.

Are you paying attention to family, friends, associates and even strangers who may not seem like theirself or something is seemingly not right with them? It only takes a few seconds out of your busy schedule to truly ask the question: Are you ok, really ok? As the image above suggests, this person looks good on the outside, but on the inside they are dying inside and crying for help. Won't you help someone today or even yourself if you are going through a difficult situation?

Please seek help, if I can save one person's life from "suicide", it will be worth it. My only wish is that someone would have

reached out to my young cousin; it may have made a difference in her life. Take some time to care and save a life.
