What's not to love about Campbelltown

Richmond Villa in Lithgow Street was built in the early 1830's by Charles Byrne. Charles mortgaged the cottage to John Vardy for 1000 pounds but unable to repay the loan he had to forfeit the house to Vardy. Vardy in turn sold it for 520 pounds to John Keighran in 1847.

Along with the contrasting Glenalvon, also in Lithgow Street (built by Charles' brother Michael Byrne) these two were among the earliest private residences in Campbelltown.

Richmond Villa is a symmetrical four roomed single storey colonial cottage. It has a fine eight panelled front door, a covered walkway links the outbuilding which was originally a kitchen to the house. Richmond Villa is rendered brick with stone flagged verandah at the front and an iron roof.

Purchased by Campbelltown City Council in 1973, it was restored with assistance from the Heritage Council and the Campbelltown and Airds Historical Society.

It is a shame that it is now towered over by the multi deck carpark behind the building. I suppose that's what some people will call "growth".
