Safety Information


IMPORTANT: Please read, understand, and comply with all of the instructions provided in this manual before using the device. Failure to comply with the instructions given in this manual and/or using the device in ways other than the ones mentioned in this manual may result in serious injury and/or damage to the product.

- **DO NOT** operate the unit if cord or plug is damaged. Doing so may result in damage to the unit or injury.
- **DO NOT** run the power cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners or similar coverings. **DO NOT ROUTE CORD UNDER FURNITURE OR APPLIANCES.** Place the power cord away from high-traffic areas.
- Only use the air purifier as described in this manual.
- **DO NOT** handle the unit with wet hands. Thoroughly dry your hands before handling any part of the air purifier.
- Hair, loose clothing and body parts can get caught in the machine and may result in injury. Keep hair, loose clothing and body parts away from openings and moving parts.
- **DO NOT** unplug the air purifier by pulling on the cord. Doing so may result in electrical spark or fire. Unplug the unit by grasping and pulling the plug.
- **DO NOT** use an extension cord with this unit.
- Place the air purifier so that the power cord easily reaches a standard electrical outlet for a polarized plug.
- **DO NOT** place the air purifier near sources of heat, such as stove tops, ovens, radiators or computers.
- Unplug the appliance from the power supply before servicing.
- This unit should be inspected frequently. Dirt that has been collected should be removed regularly to prevent excessive accumulation that may result in flashover or fire.
- **DO NOT** use the air purifier outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- **DO NOT** use the air purifier in an enclosed space where flammable, combustible or explosive gasses are present.
- **DO NOT** use in an area where toxic vapors, flammable dust or oxygen tanks are present.
- **DO NOT** place open flames, including candles, directly in front of the air purifier.
- It is important to keep all objects away from the air intake grill.
- **DO NOT** remove the back cover while the air purifier is on. Doing so will automatically turn off the unit.
- Place the air purifier on a flat, solid, stable surface. Never place the unit on soft surfaces such as a bed or sofa.
- Properly position the air purifier so that dirty air is not drawn across your head or body while sitting or sleeping.
- Child supervision is required while the air purifier is on. Do not allow children to play on or near the air purifier.
- This product is suitable for use with solid-state speed controls.


Function Diagram







Set-up

LED Display





1. Power Symbol
2. Change Filter
3. Timer
4. Air Quality Indicator
5. Auto Mode
6. Sleep Mode
7. Fan Speed

1. Open the back cover of the air purifier and remove both filters from their plastic packaging. Reinstall the filters, first with the activated carbon filter (black) followed by the HEPA filter (white). Make sure the pull tabs are facing outward.



2. Replace the back cover by aligning the bottom portion of the cover with the inlets on the bottom of the housing. Slowly close the cover by aligning the top portion of the back cover with the inlets at the top of the opening.



3. Plug the unit into an electrical outlet. The unit will chime indicating that it is connected to a power source.
4. Press the Power button to turn on the air purifier; the fan will automatically default to Low Speed.



Operation

Button Controls



On/Off button.



Press the Display button to turn on or turn off the display while the air purifier is operating.

NOTE: While the display is off, you can press any button to turn it back on to check the current operating status or change the purifier's settings. The display will turn off after 5 seconds of inactivity.



The Sleep Mode button sets the air purifier to the lowest setting possible to create a quiet environment while producing clean air. Press the Sleep Mode button to activate this function. You can press either the Sleep Mode button or the Speed button to exit out of Sleep Mode; the purifier will resume operating at its default Low Speed.

NOTE:

- Sleep Mode is the lowest fan speed.
- All other functions on the air purifier cannot be used while on Sleep Mode.



Press the Auto button to activate and deactivate the air purifier's automatic sensor mode. The automatic sensor adjusts the air purifier's fan speed according to the current air quality to provide clean air for your living space. The air quality indicator will also illuminate on the LED display; the table below shows the different colors of the air quality indicator in correlation to both air quality & fan speed. The air purifier will return to its default Low Speed when Auto Mode is turned off.

Color	Air Quality	Fan Speed
Red	Bad	High
Yellow	Moderate	Medium
Green	Good	Low
Blue	Very Good	Sleep Mode

NOTE:

- Sleep Mode cannot be activated while on Auto Mode.
- Press the Auto button to exit out of Auto Mode.



Press the Speed button to cycle through the unit's fan speeds: Low, Normal and High.

NOTE: Fan speed cannot be adjusted while on Auto or Sleep Mode.



The Timer button allows you to set the air purifier to run from 1-12 hours. To set the timer, press the Timer button to cycle through the different time settings. When you reach your desired time, the display will flash 3 times before setting. The unit will automatically power off once the timer is finished. To cancel the timer, press the Timer button until the display reads “-:-,” and wait until “-:-” flashes 3 times.




Cleaning & Maintenance

Changing and Replacing the Filters



The “Change Filter” symbol will flash on the display when the air filters in the purifier need to be changed. Follow the steps below to properly install new air filters in your unit. (Replacement filters are available for purchase on Amazon.com.)




1. Power off and unplug the device. Remove the back cover.
2. Remove both HEPA and activated carbon filters from the housing. Use the pull tabs on each filter to remove them.



3. Carefully remove the new filters from their plastic packaging and place them into the unit. The activated carbon filter (black) should be installed first, followed by the HEPA filter (white). Make sure the pull tabs are facing outward.
4. Replace the back cover onto the housing.




5. Plug in and turn the unit on. Use a pen, pencil or other small object to press the black reset button inside the reset button vent. The “Change Filter” symbol should now be off.



Cleaning The Dust Sensor

Remove the dust sensor cover and clean the lens with a cotton swab dipped in clean water. Immediately dry the sensor using a dry, clean cotton swab and close the cover.



NOTE:

- The filters cannot be cleaned manually. If necessary, purchase new filters for the unit on [Amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com).
- The back cover must be placed back on the unit in order for it to power on.
- It is recommended to change the air filters every 6 months.



Troubleshooting

Problem	Cause	Solution
Unit does not power on.	Fault in power source.	Check outlet to see if unit is working. Reset outlet if possible.
Unit is not working.	Plug not connected.	Insert the plug into an electrical outlet.
	Faulty electrical outlet.	Try another outlet.
	Back cover not properly placed on the unit.	Properly replace the back cover as noted in the Set-Up section.
Unusual noise.	Foreign object inside unit.	Contact customer service.
	Dirty filter.	Replace the filter.
	Filter does not fit properly.	Properly place filter(s) as noted in the Set-Up and Changing the Filter sections.
