

FEES FOR NON-NHS SERVICES

Most of the services your doctor provides for you are supplied under the National Health Service. There are, however, some letters, reports and other documents which are not covered by the National Health Service.

Your doctor is entitled to charge you for the time it takes to supply this information. A list of fixed fees for specific services is attached. Anything not listed will be charged according to the complexity of the requirement and will usually cost between £30.00 and £100.00.
