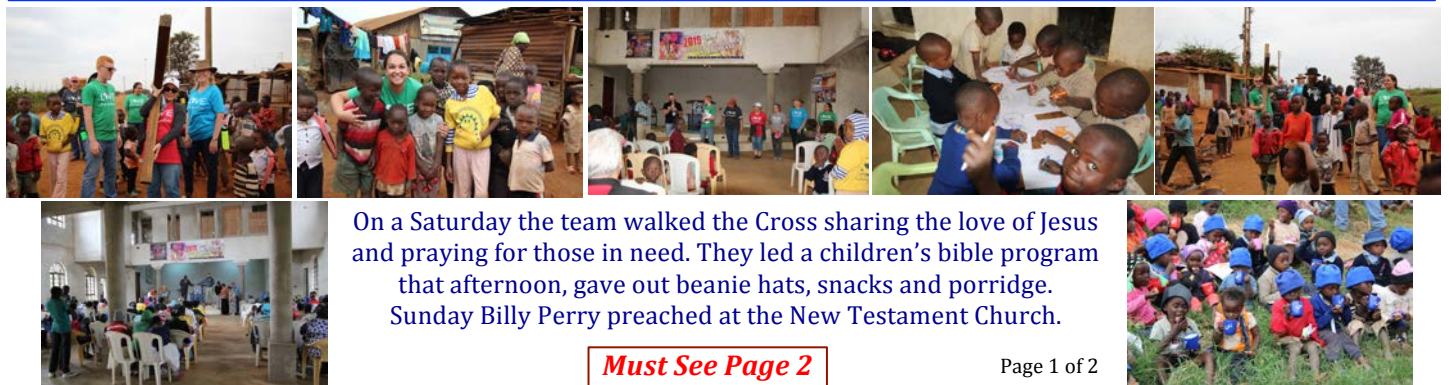

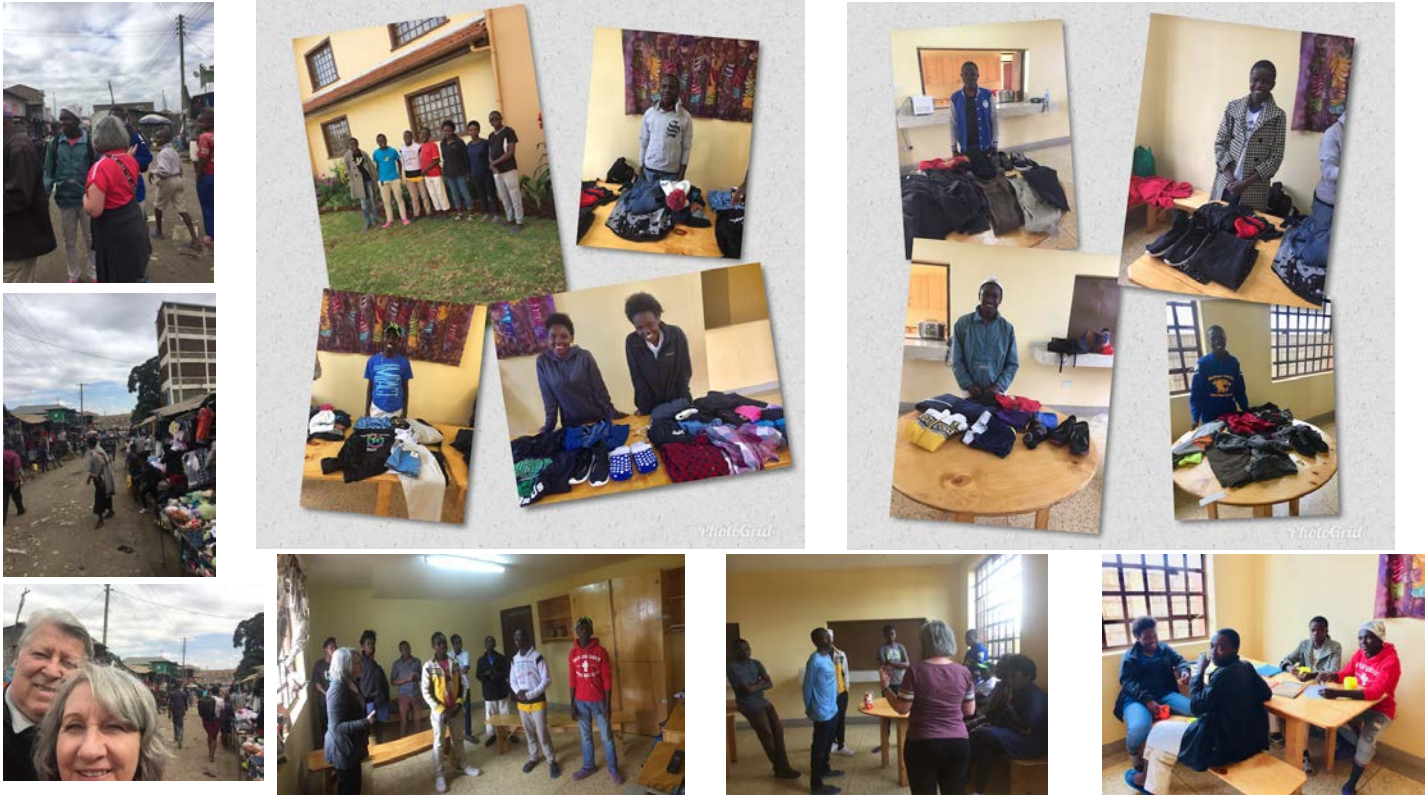


## “Impacting Africa”

A new area of ministry we have taken on is ministering and shepherding the University, College and High School Boarding School Students. These are the orphaned children that have now aged out of the “Jesus. Hobbs House of Hope Orphanage” that Kristi Hobbs with the Mercy Foundation had once supported. It is a joy for us to work with these students whom we have known and been part of from the beginning. God is allowing us to journey with them through His Word and encouraging them with their school studies. We have also been able to help them discover what they are passionate about in life and how God can take that passion and use it for their future and for His glory. Pray for God to give us wisdom and discernment, as we love these students and for strength in some of the challenging areas that we help deal with in their lives.

We found a ministry “First Love Kenya” with a facility called the Daraja House for our students to stay while on school breaks. It is a wonderful Christ centered ministry, loving staff and the students have enjoyed being there. The Daraja House is a gated and safe place for students to rest, do their school homework assignments and to play games and sports. We spent a week with them going over their school structure and grades, having a great time of morning worship and bible study. During a meeting with one of the students, we were told they needed some clothes, that most have been wearing the same pants and shirts for the past several years. We felt that as AHKI we wanted to bless the students by giving them \$30 dollars each and take them to a market to shop. Oh my!! it was a happy cry for us to see the look on their faces! They told us that this was the first time that they were ever given money to buy whatever they wanted. We had a lot of fun just watching them go at it!
