

SSPP FAQ's

What happens when a student completes the SSPP?

Full Programme Students

When a student completes the SSPP they are awarded **two** certificates. One from NTS, a Certificate of Completion as a qualified stop smoking practitioner where students are then invited to the graduation ceremony, along with the NZQA New Zealand Certificate in Health and Wellbeing (Level 3) Support Work awarded to candidates by Careerforce ITO.

Health Professional Students

When a student completes the Health Professional version of the SSPP, they are awarded **one** certificate – NTS Certificate of Completion for the SSPP as a qualified stop smoking practitioner. They are then invited to the graduation ceremony.

The reason for the one certificate is because the units achieved from the 3 Assessment Tasks, are additional units to the students prior learning.
