### **What is the difference between the TWO Certificates?**

#### **NZQA NZ Certificate at Level 3**

This is a lifetime achievement and candidate's NZQA Record of Learning will list all of the NZQA Unit Standards embedded in the SSPP that the individual has achieved. This NZ Certificate and their record of learning is evidence of their achievement in Health and Wellbeing and remains as a valid record for life, similar to other tertiary learning achievements. Candidates are able to enrol in other ongoing learning programmes that build their qualifications to NZQA Level 4 and upwards, having achieved all the requirements at Level 3.

#### **NTS Certificate of Completion for the SSPP**

This is a document to show the candidate has achieved competency in supporting people to stop smoking, similar to a diploma certificate that graduates frame and display – a visual record of competency in a particular field.
