City of Chicago, Chief Electrical Inspector, Mike Reynolds

Engineers from the region are invited to join us on Monday, September 24th at the CEE Technical Forum and Tradeshow at the Union League Club of Chicago, to learn about new initiatives in the Department of Buildings as well as commonly misunderstood areas of the new Chicago Electrical Code in Judy Frydland's keynote address. Joining her will be the City's Chief Electrical Inspector, Mike Reynolds.

Judy Frydland serves as the Commissioner of the Department of Buildings for the City of Chicago. The Department of Buildings is a 285-person department with an annual budget of \$37 million. The Department of Buildings enhances safety and quality of life for residents and visitors of the City of Chicago through permitting, inspections, trade licensing, and enforcement of the Chicago Building Code. Judy in her capacity as Commissioner is Chairperson of the newly re-formed Electrical Commission which has been active in developing new codes and standards.

Mike Reynolds is the Chief Electrical Inspector for the City of Chicago. He has worked in the Department of Buildings for eighteen years and has served as the Chief Inspector since 2015. Reynolds played a key role in the development of the new Chicago Electrical Code. Mike is also a co-chair of the Electrical Commission.
