

## Nipmuc Pond, Mendon

#### **General Information**

Nipmuc Pond is 90 acre great pond has an average depth of 12 feet and a maximum depth of 27 feet. The shoreline is almost completely developed.

#### **Recreational Access**

The town of Mendon manages launch for non-motorized cartop craft next to the town beach at 45 Taft Ave (71°33'58.44"W 42°5'53.24"N). Parking is available across the street. Please contact the town of Mendon for additional information, and/or restrictions pertaining to public access of Nipmuc Pond.

#### **Fish Populations**

The following fish species were found during MassWildlife surveys: Largemouth Bass, Smallmouth Bass, Chain Pickerel, Yellow Perch, Pumpkinseed, Yellow Bullhead, and Bluegill.

#### **Fishing**

Nipmuc Pond has produced Largemouth Bass that meet minimum sizes for recognition by the Sportfishing Awards Program.
