As a responsible organization, CSFC – Cadence Soccer & Futsal Club advocates the promotion of sportsmanship and respect to all of its coaches, administrators, participants and supporters. We realize the importance of building confidence and positive relationships among children and their peers and we both encourage and reinforce behavior that fosters those values.

We want to provide an open and communicative environment where all of our participants and their families are able to trust us and one another. And know that any concerns, anxieties, fears and hopes are important to us as an organization and that we are here to listen and provide open lines of communication between parents, players, coaches, and administrators.

CSFC – Cadence Soccer & Futsal Club is committed to providing a friendly and safe environment for participants, coaches, parents and friends, administrators, and officials. Everyone involved in CSFC activities has the responsibility of the safety and well-being of the participants and those around them.

The following are set guidelines and expectations for behavior:

1. Every participant's family, friends, and supporters will conduct themselves in a positive and encouraging manner for all the players and coaches at all times. Negative behavior, comments, and criticism about any player, coach, administrator, or official will not be tolerated.
2. CSFC – Cadence Soccer & Futsal Club participants will always remain the main focus of the program and experience, and it is the duty of all participant's family and supporters to realize and communicate the positive life lessons learned when a player experiences adverse or negative conditions.
3. Anyone suspicious of questionable conduct is responsible for reporting all cases of such behavior to an appropriate CSFC representative.
4. Any abuse – physical, emotional, verbal, or sexual, is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated in any form by any person affiliated with CSFC, its participants, their families, or otherwise. This includes, but is not limited to, hitting, kicking, biting, bullying, threatening, intimidating, mocking, making abusive statements in regard to a person's race, religion, ethnicity, age, or gender, unwanted physical contact, and inappropriate touching. All incidents of any such activity or display of abuse is strictly prohibited.
5. It is CSFC's responsibility to respond to all allegations of abuse quickly and deliberately. All relevant information will be reviewed by objective CSFC administration. This information may also be communicated to the authorities for investigation of such allegations call for cause. Any and all alleged offenders will be promptly notified of such allegations by CSFC administration.
6. Any person accused of physical, emotional, verbal or sexual abuse or misconduct may be asked to leave CSFC as well as not participate in any CSFC activities, programs, or events regardless of criminal or civil guilt in the accused case of abuse on the basis of detriment to CSFC and its participants and affiliates by their continued presence.
