Sean loves young dog training, and working with handlers and their dogs to help them develop the skills needed for success. His experience speaks for itself as a MH/SH/JH Judge and titling in all levels, 300+ Master Hunter Passes, placements in Field Trials, dogs in the Master National Hall of Fame, #3 in the country in 2014 by Retrievers Online, and has trained dogs for some of the biggest names in the waterfowl industry.

MASTER WORKSHOP (One Day) -

Thursday May 2nd, 2019. **A full day of focus on Master**. Dogs currently running/ready to run. Setting up Master Tests in training to make you more successful in tests. How to read and evaluate factors of a test. Drills to do during the week to make you and your dog a better team. Handlers will have an opportunity to work on their specific issues at the end of the day if time permits.

SENIOR WORKSHOP (Two Days) -

Friday May 3rd and Saturday May 4th, 2019. Focus on progressing to Senior. Ideal for those ready to start or have started Senior training. The starting point will be with basics from three handed casting, force to pile, T work, and swim-by. Marking work will focus on line manners, singles, starting doubles. Blind progression from pattern blinds, to pattern blinds with diversions and moving to cold blinds. Handlers will learn how to use factors such as wind, terrain and cover into your training and tests. Last if time permits marking with transitioning to triples and adding blinds into the marking setups. Sean will cover as much material as time allows. Prerequisites for working teams such as force fetch and collar conditioning will not be covered as those topics could be full days in themselves.

Working Spot Team Requirements -

Master - Currently running Master / ready to run Master Senior - Dog has completed force fetched and returning with the birds reliably, understands basic collar corrections, and has a basic understanding of sitting to the whistle.
