Fall 2017 Committee Member Descriptions

Campus & Community Outreach Committee

Members of this committee will work with other student organizations and local community groups to establish new partnerships and to coordinate events and activities. This includes creating community service opportunities for IASA / ISC members, as well as the international student community. This Committee reports to the Director of Campus & Community Outreach.

Cross-Cultural Engagement & Events Committee

Members of this committee will plan and organize events and activities that spread international cultural awareness on campus and in the local community through activities such as International Culture Night, Language Tables, Cultural Expos, etc. Members will be required to attend and assist with at least 75% of these cross-cultural events. This Committee reports to the Director of Cross-Cultural Engagement & Events.

Fundraising Committee

Members of this committee will plan and organize fundraising opportunities for IASA / ISC, including percentage nights, bake sales, etc. Members will be required to attend and assist with at least 75% of these fundraising events. This Committee reports to Treasurer & Director of Fundraising.

Public Relations Committee

Members of this committee will promote IASA / ISC and the activities, events, and programs that they coordinate. In addition, members will sometimes assist in promoting general international cultural awareness on campus through PR campaigns. Projects that this committee will work on include flyers, t-shirt designs, videos, and graphics. This committee reports to the Director of Public Relations, Linh Nguyen.

Social Events Committee

Members of this committee will plan and organize various social events that IASA has throughout the semester, including welcome week activities, Sardis Lake Cookout, tailgating tents, Halloween Costume Night, etc. Members will be required to attend and assist with at least 75% of these social events. This Committee reports to the Director of Social Events, Vinny Udeshi.

Sports & Athletic Events Committee

Members of this committee will plan and organize various sports and athletic events for IASA / ISC members, as well as the general international student community. This includes one-time championship events (i.e. soccer world championship), weekly team sport activities (i.e. basketball nights), sport education events (i.e. Football 101), and participating in intramural sports. Members will be required to attend and assist with at least 75% of these sports & athletic events. This Committee reports to the Director of Sports & Athletic Events.

General Committee Member Expectations

- Attend all meetings for your specific committee (typically twice a month)
- Attend with at least 50% of IASA events / activities, and assist as able (Note: If your committee requires a higher rate of attendance, you should abide by that number instead)
- Participate in IASA programs as available (i.e. Conversation Partners / English Cluster Teachers)
