Director of Sports & Athletic Programming

Position Specific Job Responsibilities

- Stay informed on Campus Recreation intramural sports policies / deadlines, as well as any others that are relevant, and help to communicate this information to international students
- Establish intramural teams for IASA and ISC members
- Oversee and lead the Sports & Athletic events committee, which will assist in planning activities and playing leadership roles on intramural, and other teams, created by this committee

General IASA Officer Expectations

- Attend weekly IASA leadership team meetings
- Attend bi-weekly ISC meetings, as available
- Attend at least 75% of IASA events / activities, and assist as able

Position Specific Requirements

- Must have been involved with IASA for at least one semester (this can include Spring 2018)
- Must have a working understanding of the most common sports (i.e. soccer & basketball) and have the ability to teach others the basics of how to play them
