

# 2018 CSAS Patriots Team Fees

As we head into our pre-season, I wanted to give you the costs involved for each player. Please understand that while fees are not due for tryouts, if your son makes the team, they are due and must be paid before he can participate in games. If you need to discuss fee payment, please feel free to see me or email me. Also, if you are unclear about any or all of these fees, let me know.

Below is the breakdown of costs, with an explanation for each. **All Team Fees can be paid online by going to [www.mycsas.com](http://www.mycsas.com).** The other option is to pay directly to us - preferably with check. We order the socks and shorts and distribute to players. Thanks.

Fee	Reason	Comments
\$75	Team Supplies and Costs	<p>Generally used for things like paint, referee fees, scrimmage and tournament costs and other various fees paid by program, etc. We have added in a trainer for our home games, which has bumped the team fee a little bit. However, we have long felt this area of safety needed to be addressed.</p> <p>This fee includes the TSSAA registration fee that used to be paid separately.</p> <p>Each player is responsible for this fee paid to "CSAS Soccer."</p>
\$8 (per pair)	Team Socks	All players must have at least one pair of white <b>AND</b> one pair of navy socks. If needing new ones, that would be \$16 total. You may use socks from previous year if they match. Fee paid to "CSAS Soccer."
\$28.50	Navy Shorts	Players must wear shorts that match team's uniform. You may use previous year's pair if still in good condition. Fee paid to "CSAS Soccer."

We will also be going to an overnight trip (Varsity only) to Murfreesboro for a tournament. While the costs are not set yet, the expected cost per player will be around \$75 for room and meals.

I understand that these are pricey, but at least the shorts and socks are not required on a yearly basis. They are only on an "as needed" basis and are yours to keep. Thanks and again, let me know what you do not understand.
