

6-for-6 Westbury Driver To Try for No. 7 Tonight

WESTBURY, L. I., July 13

—Jimmy Cruise, who set a New York harness track record by driving to six victories in six starts last night, will attempt to add to the mark tomorrow night at Roosevelt Raceway.

The 40-year-old sulky rider will handle the reins behind Go Lucky in the first, a trot. He will also drive Greentree Express in the fifth, Mr. Greentree in the seventh and Irish Molly in the eighth—all paces.

Cruise broke the New York mark of five victories in five starts set by Stanley Dancer at Yonkers Raceway seven years ago. Last night, the Shepardsville, Ky., driver began his record surge at Roosevelt by winning with Mighty Signal in the first and Black I Win in the second for a \$223.60 daily double. Then Cruise won the third, fourth, fifth and ninth races. He didn't compete in the sixth, seventh and eighth.
