

Abbatiello's Six Wins Ties Yonkers Record

Yonkers—**Carmine Abbatiello** won six races last night, equaling the Yonkers Raceway record set by Hall of Famer Herve Filion more than 10 years ago. **Abbatiello**, of Colt's Neck, N. J., tied the record in the 10th and final race, driving home Pop Star to a nose victory over Keystone Hooligan and William Gilmour. Pop Star was clocked in 2:03 2/5 and paid \$7.20.

Abbatiello, who has won five races on one card five previous times, brought home Isn't She Lovely (\$4.60) in the third race, Noble Pride N. (\$6.60) in the fifth, Kreizer's Yamis (\$10.20) in the sixth, Speedy Jeffrey (\$6.00) in the eighth and longshot Tremor (\$41.80) in the ninth.

Heavily favored In Rhythm overtook Florida Line midway through the \$32,000 feature at Aqueduct and went on to an easy 3/4-length

victory in a field of seven.

Trained by Edward Kelly and ridden by Angel Cordero Jr., the 6-5 choice from Brookfield Farms opened a narrow lead and won in 1:52 3/5 over the 1 1/4-mile inner track.

In Rhythm, a 6-year-old chestnut mare by Grey Dawn II-In Tempo, returned \$4.40, \$2.80 and \$2.40. Noras Lass placed at \$3.40 and \$3.00 and Halo Again showed at \$2.60.

Woody's Wish took the lead in the turn and held on for a 1 1/2-length win over Skootin Skooter in the featured Spotted Line Purse at Bowie Race Course.

Ridden by Mike Lucas, Woody's Wish completed six furlongs in 1:11 2/5. Skootin Skooter, the pacesetter in the field of seven 3-year-olds, was four lengths ahead of Undertheinfluence.
