

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST

The San Gabriel Valley District offers scholarships to graduating seniors intending to enroll in a college or university. Students planning to pursue any area of study, excluding music, may apply. Scholarships of \$500 will be rewarded.

Applicant Must Meet the Following Minimum Requirements:

1. Have a 3.0 GPA
2. Be a legal resident of the San Gabriel Valley District
3. **Have verification of Legal Presence in the United States of America** (acceptable list of verification of legal presence in the United States documents attached)
4. Be a graduating high school senior entering college or university in the fall
5. Be an active participant in one or more organizations in the community

Application Process:

1. Only two (2) applicants per high school
2. **Application Packet** must include the following items:
 - o Academic Scholarship Application filled out completely and legibly
 - o One (1) Page Essay of student's activities including:
 - School activities and responsibilities in other organizations
 - Membership and responsibilities in other organizations
 - Pastimes and hobbies
 - Work, including types of jobs, hours and duties
 - o Future goals
 - o Resume
 - o At least one letter of recommendation from the high school principal, counselor, teacher and/or community leader
 - o Official transcript of student's grades, including un-weighted and weighted grade point average. **THE TRANSCRIPT IS OBTAINED FROM SCHOOL IN SEALED ENVELOPE. IF ENVELOPE IS OPENED, STUDENT WILL BE DISQUALIFIED**
 - o Copy of Legal Presence in the United States of America document (Acceptable list of verification of legal presence in the United States documents attached)

Completed Application Packet must be delivered to the sponsoring (local) Woman's Club Chairman no later than Monday, April 2, 2019:

1. Failure to complete the Application form properly or to include all required items in the Application Packet will eliminate the student from competition
2. Winners and sponsoring clubs will be notified prior to the June 14, 2019 District Board Meeting. District Scholarship recipients will be presented at the **June 14, 2019** District Board Meeting.
3. Proof of college enrollment must be submitted by the student to the District Financial Secretary before November 30, 2019, or scholarship will be forfeited.

CLUB SCHOLARSHIP CHAIRMAN'S INSTRUCTIONS

Club Chairman must turn in **three (3)** copies of the complete student Application Packet to the District Scholarship Chairman on or before **Friday, May 10, 2019**. Each copy must include the Academic Scholarship Application, one page essay of student's activities, resume, letter(s) of recommendation, and verification of Legal Presence in the USA. The one Sealed Envelope containing Official Transcripts must accompany the application packet copies.

RETURNING STUDENT ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST

The San Gabriel Valley District offers scholarships to adult women intending to enroll in continuing education. Students planning to pursue any area of study may apply. Scholarships of \$500 will be awarded.

Applicant Must Meet the Following Minimum Requirements:

- Plan to return to school for Fall 2019 or Spring 2020
- Be female at least 25 years of age
- **Have verification of Legal Presence in the United States of America** (acceptable list of verification of legal presence in the United States documents attached)
- Be a resident of the San Gabriel Valley District
- Be an active participant in the community
- Have financial need

Application Process:

- Only two (2) applications per club
- **Application Packet** must include the following items:
 1. Returning Student Academic Scholarship Application form filled out completely and legibly
 2. Written statement of financial need and plans to finance your education
 3. At least one letter of recommendation from a community leader
 4. Copy of Legal Presence in the United States of America document (acceptable list of verification of Legal presence in the United States documents attached)
 5. Verification of residence and age; copy of California Driver's License/California ID
- **Completed Application Packet must be delivered to the sponsoring (local) woman's club chairman no later than Monday, April 2, 2019**
- Failure to complete the Application Form properly or to include all required items in the Application Packet will eliminate the student from competition
- Winners and sponsoring clubs will be notified prior to the June 7, 2019 District Board Meeting
- District Scholarship recipients will be presented at the June 7, 2019 District Board Meeting Proof of enrollment must be submitted by the student to the District Financial Secretary before November 1, 2019, if fall enrollment or February 1, 2020 if spring enrollment, or Scholarship will be forfeited.

CLUB SCHOLARSHIP CHAIRMAN'S INSTRUCTIONS

Club Chairman must turn in three (3) copies of the complete Returning Student Application Packet to the District Scholarship Chairman on or before Friday, May 10, 2019. Each copy must include the Returning Student Academic Scholarship Application, written statement of financial need, letter(s) of recommendation, verification of Citizenship, and verification of residence and age.

(Acceptable Documents)

1. Birth Certificate
2. Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (Federal Form N-560)
3. Unexpired US Passport
4. Valid permanent resident (card issued by the Department of Homeland Security/US Citizenship and Immigration Services), Non-expired I-551 (issued 1977-1989) cards are acceptable.
5. U.S. Certificate of Naturalization (Federal Form N550)
6. Valid State ID Card or Driver's License
7. Documentation of approved deferred action status, which include DACA Program - Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals.
