Just a 15 minute hike up to a hidden spot will grant you over one hour of delight while you observe the gathering of a dozen scarlet-colored male birds executing their regular performance for one endearing female.

Known as a "lek" this performance led by several "cock of the rock" male birds will completely engage you and leave you smiling for the rest of the day!





After visiting the lek we stop at a cozy observation deck where we enjoy a warm cup of local coffee, tea, snacks and some more birdwatching.

This scene is filled with colorful birds eating local fruit, taking morning showers and pretentiously posing for our cameras.
