All guardians and participants of Project Graduation-Ironwood Ridge High School have been fully informed and agree to all procedures and requirements established by Project Graduation-Ironwood Ridge High School attendant to the backpack inspection and participant check-in on the night of the event.

Any graduate wishing to leave the event prior to its end at 5:00 a.m. must report to the volunteer check-in room. If the student is under the age of 18 years on May 22, 2018, a call will be placed to their guardian or parent to arrange for permission for the graduate to leave the event. For students 18 years or older on May 22, 2018, a courtesy call will be made to the parent and/or guardian letting them know the graduate has left the event. Please list below the best phone number and person to be called. It is understood that this call may come at any time during the night, and a parent or guardian must be available at these phone numbers. If a graduate leaves the party, they will not be allowed to return. If a graduate has purchased a ticket, but not checked into the party by 11:00 p.m., a call will be placed to notify their guardian or parent.
