



A Walk Down Memory Lane!

Memory Lane is a special place at Project Graduation where photo collages of IRHS Class of 2018 graduates will be on display. Graduates will be pleased to see their photo collages and it will help make Project Graduation even more memorable for them. Each family creates their own photo collage. It is simple and special for the graduates and we hope all parents will participate.

Here are the guidelines to make your student's Memory Lane Collage:

- ◆ **Maximum size of the collage is 22" x 14"** to ensure that we will have room to display the board of each student! This is half of a standard sized poster board (22" x 28"). Poster boards are generally available at stores such as Michael's, Fry's, Safeway, and Walgreens. Posters may hang vertically or horizontally. A **20" x 16" collage**, available at Walgreens, is **also acceptable**.
- ◆ **We cannot guarantee the return of your graduate's collage.**
Please use **copies of your photos** and do not use irreplaceable pictures.
- ◆ You may **decorate** the poster board with photos of your senior. Pictures can be from birth through high school, only high school, or whatever you wish.
- ◆ Collages may be as elaborate or as simple as you wish to make them. Stickers and decorative papers and items may be used, however, memory boards **MUST BE FLAT!**
- ◆ We strongly recommend that you **laminat**e your collage to provide additional protection. Office Max and FedEx are shops that do lamination.
- ◆ **DO NOT put your student's collage in a frame or use foam board.** We must be able to hang the collages with binder clips.

We suggest that you make your student's collage as soon as possible! The kids love this part of the party and those who aren't represented may be disappointed.

Collages can be turned in to the school office as soon as they are finished! **Please turn in your collage no later than 12:00 noon on May 22nd.**

Your graduate may **pick up** the collage when he/she leaves the party, or it may be picked up in the school office later in the week. **Please put your name and phone number on the back of the collage.** We will make every attempt to return it to you.
