We meet for the weekday rides at 5:50 pm and try to start our ride by 6:00 pm. Weekend rides are at unique, scenic trails with their own schedule. All levels of riders and bicycle types are welcomed and encouraged to join us and "PEDAL" with our "CIRCLE" of fun friends. Rides can be as short/long, or slow/fast as you prefer, with many riding in small groups to socialize. Scheduled rides are considered canceled in the event of rain or storm conditions.

Following the rides, participants meet for a "social party" at a local establishment for beverages and/or food. Call or text the ride contacts the evening of to confirm the location (if not listed) as it will be determined by the participants during the ride, and are likely to change weekly. Start at 11:15 am on the far end of the Marina parking lot, on the right, before crossing the bridge. Address is 684 Lake Wilhelm Rd, Sandy Lake, Pennsylvania 16145-2310. After the ride we will travel about 30 minutes Northwest to **Lago Winery** for grub and pub! Lago is at 4218 E Lake Rd, Jamestown, PA 16134
NOTE: we are skipping the Wilhelm Celebration because it occurs on a busy holiday weekend and is so close on the schedule, so we opted for this date to maximize the weather as Fall conditions are near...
