

Jesus Encounters

Beginning of Encounters at Blazing Holy Fire Church

In 2013, 12 faithful prayer warriors who met at the church had a deep encounter from the Lord that has changed our lives forever. It all began when the youngest prayer warrior in our midst - a teenage at the time fell deeply in love with Jesus after undergoing through a powerful deliverance in which she received the gift of speaking in tongues and many other gifts from the Lord. Though she was taking summer school, she committed to wake up early in the morning and spend 2 hours with the Lord in prayer before going to school. As even she started attending nightly church corporate prayers, Jesus began to manifested Himself to her, took her to the throne room in heaven, giving her a message for the church and all the members. From then on, Jesus started coming every night in His manifest presence and spoke to all of us sometimes as a group or one on one. The Lord took us to heaven and hell every night and shared with us great and mighty things. He kindly spoke to us and trained us for a period of over one year. Here is the summary of those encounters, details will be shared in books to be written soon – Hope this bless you and bring you closer to Jesus! ~ BHF

Come, Meet My Jesus: A Brother, A Lover and A King – God Almighty!

Dear reader, beloved of the Lord: draw closer. I want you to meet the man called Jesus as we have experienced Him! Come, hear and meet the one who created you! Come, meet the one who is the answer to every problem you face. Come! I want to introduce you to God who is so, a friend who loves and sticks closer than a brother – a true friend indeed! He is God whom most of us (if not all of us) have put in a box and have a wrong idea of what He is like! I want to introduce to you the Real Jesus, whom I and the congregation of Blazing Holy Fire church have come to know in the most intimate fellowship!

We are 12 prayer warriors. We all love Jesus! For about 4 years, we have been meeting every night for powerful prayer. In the summer of 2013, it pleased Father God, Son and Holy Spirit to come and meet with us in a special way while we were going to some of our darkest moment as a church that has always done God's will. The Lord Jesus visibly came to us first in July 2013; in the beginning only showing visions. Starting the month of August 2013 however, one night the Lord Jesus manifested fully to one of the prayer warriors and took her to heaven to meet with our Father in heaven – whom Jesus taught us to call Abba Papa! Abba Papa gave a message to our church in a form of a letter detailing the purpose of those visits: Jesus coming is very, very soon. We are to sprint and declare the Kingdom of God is at hand, call all to repent and prepare them to stand before God Almighty! God promised a revival that is soon to hit the whole wide world through His righteous judgment. There will be great miracles, signs and wonders, greater than when Jesus walked the earth.

During this first encounter also, the Lord wrote letters (in some cases just only gave words) to every one of the 12 prayer warriors and to all the members of the church at the time promising an open heaven where we would finally see. He promised to take us to heaven. He also promised to show us hell, so that we can feel the intense sorrow and pain He feels for the lost. Within 2 weeks from the first encounters, He started fulfilling those individual promises and within a short time, we were all taken to heaven and hell, sometimes individually and sometimes as a group.

After this first throne encounter, the Lord began then to come visibly in our midst every night as we powerfully prayed! He would come visibly every night and He would never miss a night. By this I mean Jesus would appear in our sanctuary a few minutes after prayer began but very soon, we deeply fell in love with Him and He started even coming before prayer! I remember how we used to play the Shekinah Glory song by Cory Asbury “*We wait for you, walk in the room...*” but we stopped playing it because the song did not make sense anymore: Jesus started coming early before prayer, super excited, lovingly waiting for us! Jesus would remain as long as prayer lasted – about 1ish or the woe hours of the morning! At the close of prayer, Jesus would wait as we close up and He would escort us

from the building to our vehicles and He would vanish once we left the parking lot but sometimes He would ride with some individuals. He would then come back the next day. Prayer was the meeting place in the beginning but at times, He started even visiting us in our homes!

Jesus visitations where He started talking to us face to face were preceded by intense prayers and intense trips to hell for about a week! He took certain individuals to hell and allowed them at first to go to hell as observers from the outskirts, the next day as observers from within the gates of hell, but as we continued to pray stronger, Jesus allowed them to be tormented in hell. The cries and the torments were deep, beyond compare, beyond words that it was impossible for all prayer warriors to pray normal! It was impossible for anyone in the room to pray without being shaken! Later on we found out the more painful and intense torment in hell, the greater would be the visitations and God's glory in our midst! Hallelujah!

First Throne Encounters

When this throne encounters happened, the Lord gave a gift of heavenly language to the prayer warrior whom He first took to the throne room. In one instant, this language was downloaded into her mind – just like how you can be given the ability to speak French in an instant without going to school and we all started learning it. It would be this language that Jesus mostly used to talk to us, it was used also in the spiritual realm but there are other means the Lord began to use to communicate to us – some of them, really really supernatural – mind blowing! Oh, my beloved – God is great – God is mighty! Most of us have no idea *but "I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might (Ephesians 1:18-19).*

After this throne encounters, the Lord showed Himself fully, visibly and He started meeting with us, taking us to tour heaven and at times hell without saying many words but showing us a lot! About two weeks after these tours, we even fell more deeply in love with Jesus, praying powerfully and seeking Him with all our heart and it is then He started meeting with us where He actually talked to us. We talked to Him sometimes individually and other times as a church family. We spend many hours asking Him questions, fellowshiping with Him; sometimes He would sit at the head of the table keeping us company as we eat and drink in His presence. Sometimes He taught us many things concerning the kingdom.

When He came, He gave to each one of us heavenly names – all prayer warriors, their children and spouse, He gave us heavenly names and nicknames – sometimes funny ones but that matches your character. You all have nicknames and heavenly names – Jesus is the same, yesterday, today and forever – when you read the Bible, you can see that it is something that He did with those who were closest to Him, just like how parents like to give names / nicknames to their children!

He is definitely the person who knows you inside and outside! He knows everything about you so it is better to share everything with Him even beginning now! Do not try to keep secrets from Him. He knows your every thought – He truly is that person who lives inside of you. The Lord had given us this privilege where we in the beginning were allowed to ask Him any questions we had – I mean any! I was reserved in the beginning but the youth in our church started asking anything! Jesus would meet with one person at a time, usually beginning with the pastor and from there He would sit with the next person – one on one visitation would last from 10 minutes upto 1 hour, depending upon the level of relationship or the questions one had or situations. Sometimes He would answer our questions in a group setting. When we would sit with Him, we were amazed to see how He answers. Normally, we would be the ones asking the questions but many times when you get in His presence, every questions you thought of would disappear and here we saw the Lord's patience and power! Sometimes, He would help you to remember

or just let you be there, in wonder and amazement. We started writing down questions during the day but alas, there are times the paper would disappear just before He calls your name ... we saw how patient He is, how long-suffering and loving He is. By one touch, the memory would come back and the conversation would flow. Sometimes He revealed He was all knowing by answering the question that was next on the list without you reading it loud. He would answer something that was on our mind, something we forgot to ask, or something we were going to ask. Jesus is beyond IQ. There would be times you go into His presence with many many questions. Let's say you go in His presence and you read all 25 questions. He would patiently wait and listen, and when it is time to answer, He would answer them in that order without looking at the list of questions. He is all knowing – God beyond IQ! Jesus, He loves you more than you know, more than you can think of, more than you can imagine! He thinks about you every second. Words do not do justice to describe His love for you! He told me *“My love is deeper than any ocean; wider than any sky, and bigger than the universe. You cannot even handle a single fraction of my love. You cannot rub your mind around it.”* There is not a single person that He does not care for. There is not a single person that is forgotten or neglected by Him!

He is a Jesus who loves to spend time with you! Every time you are on your knees, He is there. Every time you call upon His name, He is right there! Anytime your heart cries out to Him, He is right there! He desires for your eyes to open so that you can see Him face to face. He encouraged us to pray harder and ask God to open our eyes but until that happens, He wants you to walk by faith and not by sight. He wants you to pray harder and press in so that one day soon you can meet Him. He wants to reveal Himself to many of you. This is not only for our church or a certain ministry; this is available for anyone who is diligently seeking Him. He told me He will open many people's eyes whom He draws to our ministry – He told me that in these end times we are living in, He is going to open the spiritual eyes like never before.

When He came to us, regardless of how difficult situations were in marriages, or in the hard cases of salvation for our beloved ones - we found He is a God that is ready to come to their rescue! No matter how impossible it seems to us. You know of those relatives whom you had begged to receive Him; and how - the more you prayed, the worse it got, and the more they rejected Him! And you know how you almost gave upon them – I have good news for you: Jesus did not give upon them! When He came to us He said *“I will save them”* and indeed we watched as He started to do a great work in them. We heard Him say *“I will heal your marriage, do not worry!”* Even in situations that were impossible! We saw Him move! He showed us how He would do it, His thoughts are not our thoughts, His way of solving different issues are beyond our comprehension! We looked and found that He is a great great mighty God - so loving and so kind; after encountering Him face to face, we saw that He is way more fun, more exciting than we imagined Him to be. Absolutely astounding! We saw that He is Jesus we had never known before though at the time of visitation I had been His disciple for 16 years! He was the Jesus we never knew, Jesus beyond what the church thinks He is and we thus started calling Him **“The Real Jesus”!**

Heaven – Your Permanent Home!

The Lord took us numerous times to heaven and showed us our mansions. Children of God, Jesus has a mansion with your name on it. On the first trip, we saw the mansions for the members of the church. Mansions were shown to us by family - The family that prays together stays together – also we later on learned that the family that prays together fights together! Wow! All the wealth and riches of this world put together could not even buy a single building in heaven! It is beyond beautiful. Every time you give a helping hand to those in need, every time you are serving God, every time you praise Him through worship, prayer, dance, and even when you bring joy and humor to your brothers and sister-materials are being sent to build your mansion in heaven. Two things that help you earn highest reward in heaven are:

1. Witnessing to the lost souls

2. Being the Bride of Christ

We are in the process of writing books and we will share more on this subject.

When we were shown our mansions, we were shocked to see that no soul is forgotten by God! Some of the congregation members who had had an abortion before they met the Lord- were surprised to be met by their children. The children were so happy and full of love. They would run to the parents to give them big hugs and say that they have forgiven the parents.

Pastor Meet Her Aborted Child - Forgiveness and Reconciliation

When the Lord took us on our first heaven tour, I saw that there were 4 mansions in total for my family. But this caused me to wonder because on earth we are just 3: my husband, my son, and I. Then I saw that the name Kiata was written on the 4th mansion! There was a beautiful girl, who in earthly terms seemed to be like 16! The Lord touched my memory and He reminded me of my little girl whom I had aborted in 1996! I was shocked, speechless and I wanted to disappear but it was not possible. When He showed us this, the congregation members were with me and they witnessed the power of love and forgiveness! In 1996, I committed abortion and a few weeks after this abortion, I was so devastated waking up to the knowledge that I had actually killed someone! The Lord found me right then, and I immediately surrendered my life to God. At that time, I gave my aborted child the name Mercy. There is a heavenly language that the Lord had given to us which we use to communicate while conversing with the Lord – In this heavenly language, my daughter's name is Kiata which translated in English means Mercy, the very same name I gave her in 1997.

When I got home after meeting my daughter, tears were welling up in my face, dripping down. I cried so much and also received deep healing! There was no sense of condemnation whatsoever because all I was given was love, forgiveness and comfort – I had repented ever since I got saved and meeting my daughter in heaven just brought forth a deep healing and it was sealed in the blood of Jesus. When I woke up, I picked up the phone to call my younger sister whom I owed also an apology for what I did and I had kept that a secret to myself – only a few people knew including my husband. As we talked, she forgave me and comforted me. She then asked if I got to see her mansion, I said I did. She asked me how many mansions I had seen for her family and there were 6. This also I could not understand because on earth it was her husband, 2 children and herself. It should have been 4 mansions. She then reminded me that she had one miscarriage and had also committed an abortion! See both of us committed abortion but we did not share with each other! Our secrets were exposed. We forgave each other and we rejoiced in the Lord who is so merciful to forgive ex-serial killers like us. There are more similar stories that we will share in due time from these trips! There is a couple in our church that has had 3 miscarriages! Their babies are very happy in heaven waiting to be reunited with their parents, currently this couple was remembered by the Lord and He has blessed them with twins and another son. In heaven, their 8 mansions are there waiting for them!

Heaven is a place for fun and lots of fun!

In heaven we got to have so much fun. I was a pastor that was serious and the Lord took many weeks to set me free and to teach me to have fun and flow with jokes and humor. Jesus is very humorous and very playful! He dances, He plays, He has sooo much fun! In heaven, the Lord lets us fly with angels, and ride inside the chariots of fire. There are those who walked on water, went whale riding, went star gazing etc... In my mansion there is a tiger I got to ride on. There is a huge lion that follows Jesus around in heaven, one of the prayer warriors got to ride it when she won a battle she had fought in hell, a battle with satan! In heaven, we got to worship and holy danced before God, all together with the saints in heaven. We got to meet the Apostles Paul, Peter, John and other disciples and saints! When we met the saints, the Lord allowed them to impart blessings to us and sometimes gave counsel – everything

they told us it was only by God's permission and how true it was – in heaven, all the saints are moved by the Spirit of God – no one can do or say anything that is not in accord with God's will and order.

When we met with the saints, the Lord would allow them sometimes to give us a word of wisdom, or advice. We got to meet with many saints from Bible times but also our beloved ones who had gone on before us and some modern saints such as Choo Thomas. She is on the third level of heaven and her mansion is very close to the throne of God, she is very very happy. The Lord said, "She is finally at home", her heart is full, overjoyed! The Lord told me many great things about her that I am not allowed to share at this moment. The saints would sometimes give us an impartation.

There was a time I asked the Lord if He could leave this window of opportunity open, so that I could always ask questions face to face. The Lord joked about it and said, "*Why do you ask so little, why would you choose to have little faith? Why wouldn't you ask for me something big instead? Something bigger -such as a door? ...*" Later on He came to teach me Great Faith and commanded me instead of asking for an open window, that I should ask an open field, a microphone hanging from the sky, without walls without limit – to preach the good news to all creation all over the world. I did and He gave me an open field. He then promised me that He will let me ask questions anytime, but He warned me "*you might not always understand my answers.*"

Immediately after He said this, King Solomon appeared and gave me wisdom/understanding impartation. Many times prayer warriors have received impartation from Esther, David and other saints. Being in the fire ministry, one of the saints that I had met with often was Elijah. He would give me a fire impartation and would caution me "*Use the fire well and keep up hope!*" In heaven there is always worship. There is so much fun! And there are so many places to go!

Sometimes the Lord would take us to heaven as a whole church; but most of the time He takes us in a small group or one person at a time. In the beginning we went without our eyes spiritually opened, but those whose spiritual eyes were open would lead the way. As they looked at us in heaven, they said we looked as if our eyes were closed, or like we were blind. They would tell us how we would bump into things, or appear clumsy, but God is merciful and He continued to guide us. These were joyful and humorous experiences. We also learned about, how in heaven, we do not wear earthly cloths, but instead change into heavenly garments. Women in our church dream about having long hair, when we would go to heaven, we would have long hair with jewelry in it.

There are times the Lord would show us how He paints the sky. Each day He is the one who decides how the sky looks though the enemy try to mess it up; He would show us how the clouds lay, how the light streaks, how the colors mix, and how it would appear at each moment in time. Not only did He let us watch Him, but He even taught us how to create with Him and He let us create! There are many times when He would make a flower, then have us mimic Him. We were able to create flowers also. He is a God who wants us to rule and reign with Him (Revelation 20:6). As we talked to Him daily face to face, we experienced His love flowing out from His heart to us, and to His children all over the world, we deeply fell in love with Him. He would often tell us "*Just mimic me...*"

Jesus' City & Father God's House

There are times that the Lord would take us to His city where He has His castle. The Lord said that those whose eyes were already open could tour the place, but those whose eyes had yet to be opened could not enter into His holy city. Since the Lord was in the process of opening all of our eyes, those with opened eyes said "No, we will wait for the whole family so we can tour it together." Also, there have been many times when those whose eyes had already been opened got to see Father God on His throne. Before His throne, everyone lay prostrate on their face. The further you get from the throne, the higher you can raise your head. Eventually, people can stand and worship towards the back of the throne room.

There were times when Abba Papa instead of Jesus would send a message to the church regarding the affairs of the church or regarding which battles to fight in the spiritual realm, or sometimes words regarding an individual- In this case, Jesus and the angels would escort that person to Father God's private kingly chamber where the person(s) receive the message. When the individual is there we all can tell from the church. They are facedown. From this we have learned that you can converse with Jesus standing, sitting, and sometimes visiting as He takes you for walks but before Father God you have to fall prostrate (we have seen a few exception where actually we walked with Aba Papa).

After meeting Jesus for a few weeks or months, our relationship grew stronger and He began to introduce us to Our Father God whom we began to call Abba Papa. One Sunday night, after 13 fierce battles that God allowed us to fight against satan, we gained a major victory and Abba Papa for the first time came to visit us as a church. We all fell prostrate on the floor for a while. Another time, on a Monday night Abba Papa came after winning another great victory against the hordes of satan. Abba Papa was very joyful and He spoke to us from a heavenly portal – in a deep voice! What a loving loving Father! He spoke to us for about 15 minutes and we were all prostrate on the floor. From then on, He would visit us about one Monday every month and He would speak to us!

During this time of visitations, for about the first 3 months, the visits were deep and intense – the Lord kept all visitors away so that He can accomplish the process He had started in our midst. Our church was on a busy street where all who pass by could see the church, drop in any time; but though not advertised, visitors with a few exception were kept away for about 3 months of intense visits and trip to hell! To go through that type of intense visitation requires great preparation which the Lord has to take you through.

Experiencing God's Great Love

The Lord is very loving. Words do not do justice to describe His love for you! He is not a God who is sitting on the throne counting your sins and looking for the next moment to hit you, judge you, or condemn you. Every single second, His heart is beating for each of us. Especially for sinners, He is begging them to come to repentance. If they don't repent, they will end up in Hell. He desperately does not want any of His children to go there.

Jesus would spend most of the time training us in warfare prayer, intercession, battles etc... He would spend time with us talking to us and giving us instructions. During prayer, He would lead us either into deep intercession, while that is going on, there would always be intense trips to hell where those with that calling are experiencing different types of torment with the Lord's permission – it is the Lord who lead them to accomplish different missions. At the same time, the Lord would be multitasking, meeting people, touching us as we reach out to Him in deep prayers. My favorite time with Him was conversing one on one! Oh, I love to talk to the Lord. I love to talk to Him! Once you hear His voice, it is sweeter than honey, you cannot live without it, it is sort of addicting at least that's how I felt. I would be almost sick if I could not hear His voice and the Lord prescribed for me a daily dose where He would talk to me one on one every night. Thank you Lord for that privilege!

During break time, the Lord would share joyful moments with us – He would have us pray in tongues and interpret them for us, it was always lots of fun when we did that and He would teach us many things. He taught us to have discernment, submission, love, great faith, how satan destroys churches and ministry and much more – He is the greatest Rabbi! He always warned us that there is great warfare ahead, that times are going to get much harder but that He will be with us always! He would say "warfare is coming but so am I!" More often, He would tell us "SMILE AND BE HAPPY!"

From the time He met us to this day, our everyday meetings consist of powerful prayers, worship, spiritual warfare, the word and at times being taken to hell and spiritual realms.

The Lord taught us that there are 3 types of love that He shows us. There are times He wants us to be funny and share humor. There are times where He is a King and His majesty is overflowing. Sometimes we converse with Him as:

1. Brother and Friend

Those who are young in our midst; teenagers and early twenties, had so much fun with Him while He was showing this type of love. Young people seem to connect with Him in that area. He would not be offended for example when some of them would ask: "Lord, how old are you?". He would actually answer them! One even asked if Adam and Eve had belly buttons! One night one of us asked what shoe size He wears, knowing it would be big because He is so gigantic. He said in earthly terms, around a 22 men's shoe size. They asked personal questions whether the Lord sleep. They asked questions regarding singleness and He is interested when single people ask those type of questions and He gave answers. When the Lord answers, it is the words of wisdom beyond anything you have ever seen or heard. When He talks, it is so entertaining and so anointed that your ears get on fire as you listen and you do not want the conversation to end.

The Lord is very, very patient. My little boy was then 5 years. There are times the Lord would call me to talk and it was almost time to send my son to sleep. In this case, the Lord would wait patiently for me. There are times people would go to him with pages of questions or asking words to give to the people. He is always very patient. When we apologize for our long questions, He would say "*I have patience... It is important that my children hear My voice and know how much I love them! They have been searching for Me like one who is looking for a drop of water in the wilderness! They are reaching out to me!*" There are times some people would ask Him the same questions they had asked the day before! The Lord would still give them the answer without judgment. When He meets with those who are weak, He does not criticize, but strengthens them. When He meets with those who need encouragement, He does brings them joy and hope; and teaches them how to stay strong in Him. The Lord gives us always compliments and tells us from His heart what He thinks about certain words we shared with Him. He is also playful and sometimes when we ask questions, He let us guess so that we can play with Him. There are many questions He does not answer directly; instead He says "*I am a God of mystery... Wait and see!*" Though He is a God who is playful, He is also a King and He always asserts His authority.

2. Lover, Bridegroom

On Tuesday September 3rd 2013, Jesus came to me and when I asked Him of what He thought about Rosh Hashana He excited said, "*Rosh Hashana is My Wedding Day*". As a church, we have always celebrated this holy day but this time it was going to be much different. Per His instructions, all the prayer warriors who are already brides to Him were to renew their vows but especially 2 in our midst were going to get married to Him for the first time, on the last day of Rosh Hashanah (September 6).

Jesus took this feast very serious. He came on the first day of Rosh Hashana dressed in white, on the 2nd day He came back also dressed in white with a crown on His head. He asked me to tell Him about the plans for the wedding day which were to take place the following day. When I shared, He said that it was an outline. He asked me what was to be the plan for the feast. I had not thought about it as a feast. He said "*Have you been to a wedding without a feast? Why would it be any different for me?*" With this, we had a quick meeting and we made better plans for the wedding day.

He made provision for everything we needed. He picked wedding cloths for each one of us. We were dressed very nicely. When people went shopping the angels would go with them and Jesus would accompany us. He told us He literally picked cloths for each of His children.

The men had questions for Him regarding men being His brides! The Lord spoke to me and said: *“Tell them that physical appearance does not make a bride beautiful to me. Male and female does not matter in how I consider someone a bride. It is humbling for man to be my bride, because on earth they are held superior in authority to women; but I want them to let go of the standards they hold on earth. They are not the standards I have set for them. Tell those who do not feel like they are yet able to relate to me in a bridal way, to look at these vows as a contract between brothers, a business deal that binds them to me, but one made out of kinship and love. These vows are contracts; they complete and solidify the intimate and deep friendship they have with me.”* He made us laugh when He said, *“I created man first! Man should connect more intimately with me but some do not.”*

3. Father and King

He has so much love for us as a father. When we are in His presence, we are His children. He takes care of us and He does not want anyone of us to worry about anything. He says *“Bring me the worries, bring me the burden.”* As a praying church for many years, we had so much warfare. In our midst, there were hard cases of relatives whom we had almost given up on. When we took their names to the Lord and asked Him to please save them, He would always say *“Yes, I will save that person. I am watching the sins they are making but because of your prayers, I will bring them on their knees”*. So dear God’s children, pray without ceasing.

Where there were impossible marriage problems, He would converse with us and He would say, *“I will heal your marriage”*. There was not a single case where He said ‘no, I cannot save that person, I cannot heal, I cannot intervene.’ We found out many times we did not have because we asked not. When we would ask Him how to reach out to the people, He would guide us and give us words to tell them in the most profound wisdom there can be. It is all summed up in this, *“Tell them about me. Tell them how loving I am. Tell them how good and kind I am. Tell them that I do not want them to go to hell. Tell them about the rewards awaiting them. Keep telling them about Me. Introduce Me to them.”* He has a great heart for the lost. When we go in the street, He accompanies us and at the end of the day when we fellowship with Him, He would tell us how many people were saved that day. How many will make it in the rapture and how many will be left behind.

Jesus Loves Pastors

Jesus loves the pastors. He desires to meet them face to face but He said many pastors are backsliding. He said *“I love them so very much. But they are jumping out of my hand. Many of them don’t want to be held by Me. They don’t want to have the patience and the perseverance to stand by Me when things get hard. They are turning away from Me. They are tired of waiting on me but I want them to endure. I want them to know I have great rewards for the pastors”*. Jesus loves you pastors! He sees every battle you are in. Please don’t give up, keep up your hope. He knows every battle you have been in and He is coming for you but you must hold on and not give up. I would advise every pastor to pray hard and meet the Lord face to face. Many times we pastors think our church is the best but do not guess and do not be so sure...! If we think like that we could be in for some great shock at the judgement day. The Lord showed me the churches He does not approve and gave me a message for pastors. If you are a pastor, feel free to contact me so I can share that message with you. If your church is not going out to witness regularly, if you do not go out in the streets and witness, quickly reform! Do the ministry like He did! He met the people where they were at, He did not wait inside the temple for the people to come to Him. The Lord showed that the church has let go off what He died for ... we pastor need to repent more than anyone else! This is very serious, one night He talked to me about it, I shook and I trembled like a leaf in His presence.

The Lord does not want anyone of His children going to hell. He has shared with me how His heart will be always burdened by those He loves but are lost to hell. Those in hell were His children! He does not want even a single person to go there. He shared with me that once the judgment is set at the end of the age, His heart will still be burdened by those lost forever in hell. But when we, His bride enter into the joy of eternity, His burden will lighten

because we will enter into His safety and that will bring Him more joy and peace than we are able to comprehend; all because He will see us happy and finally at home.

Intimate Wedding Ceremony

When the wedding day arrived, it was Friday September 6th 2013. The wedding feast started at 7pm and lasted till 3 am. The Lord was with us the whole time. Two new brides were married to Him in a beautiful ceremony in front of many witnesses. All of us who have accepted Him and walked with Him renewed our vows. Vows were to be said out loud. One by one, we stood as a bride next to Him under the chuppah. By 7pm, the Lord was already on the platform of the sanctuary. We were not to wear high heels on the altar, only bare or sandals. Continue to seek God, regardless of how much warfare you face. Continue to seek His holy face regardless of what surrounds you. Jesus wants you to pray harder – this means to pray with all your heart fully focused on him, fully connected to Him, fully devoted to Him. Do not let your heart, mind, body, or soul wonder away from Him. He keeps reminding us that with the little time we have left, praying hard is a must. He keeps reminding us that He is coming soon and that we must do His work of reaching out to the lost in the name of the Lord. We must go in the highways and byways and declare “*The Kingdom of God is at hand! Repent and believe in Jesus! Prepare yourself to stand before the Lord your God!*”
