League Overview

Southern Nevada 9 Ball was established in 1975. It was designed and built with Las Vegas Tavern Owners, Bartenders and Pool Players in mind. It is one of the oldest continuously running Tavern Pool Leagues in the country. We would be glad to meet with Owners, Managers and Bartenders to explain how pool leagues work and how they can be beneficial to both owners and bartenders and give your customers something to do to stay at your bar longer. 1. SN9BALL is a cash league. We give away over \$40,000 in cash and prizes for each season. Plus 2 entries into the "Doc" Hill Memorial Tournament 1 Entry into the Andy Mercer and 1 entry to the Women's Western Open each February.
2. Teams consist of 5 people (4 in Adam & Eve).
3. SN9BALL plays a round robin format. That is beneficial because everyone plays each player on the opposing team once instead of playing one player a few games. This keeps the team at your bar the entire night instead of players coming in to play their match and then leave. Better liquor sales and tips.
4. A match consists of 25 games for 9 Ball & 8/9 Combo divisions, 20 games for Adam & Eve.
5. Player weekly fees are \$10.00 per player per night with the exception of the Advanced divisions which is \$11.00 per player per night.
6. Start time for all divisions is 7:30 p.m. except for the WOMEN'S and ADAM and EVE divisions where the start time is 7:00 p.m.
7. Seasons are 21 weeks plus turkey shoots, playoffs and end of season party.
8. Each bar gets 9 to 11 home games a 21week season. Plus, the playoffs if your team qualifies.

What is the Tavern's responsibility?

- #1 – Get 4 or 5 people (depending on the night) together that like pool and want to have a good time out once a week.
- #2 – Have a pool table that is in good condition.
- #3 – League play is free for team players players. Some bars open the tables and some pay for the games.
- #3 – Each team member on night of play gets a team round. This is what they have been purchasing that night and is usually after the 3rd round.
- #4 – Tavern entry fee is \$70.00 per team per season.

What can the Tavern's reasonably expect?

Each night of play you should have a minimum of 10 people at your Tavern for pool. Most team do eat and drink at least some. A conservative revenue estimate would be \$100 - \$200 a match (about and average of \$10 to \$20 per player).

More Teams Mean More Revenue.

Limited to 2 "A" players per night / per team.

Thursday West Side Women's 9 Ball Single Foul

5-person teams. Women ONLY no men.
Limited to 2 "A" players per night / per team.

5-person teams. Any combination men & women.
