

# Southern Nevada 9 Ball Tournament Series Rules and Procedures

(Open to Southern Nevada 9 Ball players that have played in at least 50% of current season matches)

Registration starts at 1:00 pm – Tournaments start at 2:00 pm

Entry is \$20.00 per player

Tournament is Double Elimination – Flip coin for 1<sup>st</sup> break / Alternate Break

Races are to players handicap

## Tournament Schedule

Tournament #1 – Saturday June 16<sup>th</sup> – 9 Ball Single Foul – Putters Eastern / **Confirmed Location**

Tournament #2 – Saturday July 14<sup>th</sup> – Scotch Doubles – Front Row / **Confirmed Location**

Tournament #3 – Sunday August 12<sup>th</sup> – 9 Ball Single Foul – Location TBA

Tournament #4 – Saturday September 15<sup>th</sup> – 9 Ball Single Foul – Location TBA

Tournament #5 – Saturday October 20<sup>th</sup> – Scotch Doubles – Location TBA

Tournament #6 – Saturday November 10<sup>th</sup> – 9 Ball Single Foul – Location TBA

Final Tournament – Saturday December 15<sup>th</sup> – 9 Ball Single Foul – Location TBA

## Handicap System

The handicap for players will be based on their league average.

Below is the handicap guideline. These are for winner side of 9 Ball Single Foul.

For Scotch Doubles team handicap will be an average of both team players league average.

Loser side minus 1 game across the board. (MIN 2 GAMES NEEDED TO ADVANCE ON LOSERS SIDE).

0 – 450 average will race to 2

451 - 550 average will race to 3

551 - 650 average will race to 4

651 & over average will race to 5

The 1<sup>st</sup> Tournament will be only 2 weeks after the start of the season so “known” player strength might be factored into players handicap the 1<sup>st</sup> Tournament.

“A” players & some advanced division players will add 1 games to all races.

This will be decided by SN9BALL at time of Tournament

SN9BALL does reserve the right to adjust any players handicap at any time for the Tournaments.

Keep in mind that a player with a high average doesn't necessarily mean they are an “A” player.

Also, just because they beat you doesn't make them an “A” player.

## Prize Fund – Monthly and for Final Tournament

Entry for all the Tournaments including the final tournament is \$20.00

\$10.00 of each monthly Tournament entry fee go to the monthly Tournament prize fund along with \$100.00 added.

The other \$10.00 gets held until the final Tournament in December.

## Awards for the Monthly Tournaments

1<sup>st</sup> place will be 50% of the prize fund (\$10.00 per player) plus 6 points toward final Tournament.

2<sup>nd</sup> place will be 30% of the prize fund (\$10.00 per player) plus 4 points toward final Tournament.

3<sup>rd</sup> place will be 20% of the prize fund (\$10.00 per player) plus 3 points toward final Tournament.

All other players will receive 2 points towards final Tournament

## Qualifying for the Series Final Tournament

The top 32 players in the standings (most points) will play in the final.

The prize fund for will be the \$10.00 per player per Tournament from the monthly Tournaments plus, an added \$100.

Handicaps will stay in effect.
