The Ethel Montgomery Scholarship Fund was established in the 1990s to assist university-level Alaska Native students majoring in museum studies. Ethel Montgomery, one of the first docents at the Alaska State Museum and longtime member of the Friends, was adopted into the Kaagwaantaan Wolf Clan and became an active member of the Alaska Native Sisterhood. One of her dreams was to help young Alaska Natives become curators and directors of museums that celebrate their cultures. The combination of her love for museums and for the Native people contributed to her establishment of this scholarship.

The recipient of this scholarship must be enrolled in an Alaskan federally-recognized tribe and must be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree related to museum studies.

- An essay (750 words maximum) that describes
 - Your educational plans and goals
 - How this scholarship will help you achieve your educational goals
