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Rauceby School STEM/RAF 100 Week

This week has been STEM and RAF 100 week at Rauceby. STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. Our theme has been *flight* where we looked at everything from rockets to the mars to Humpty Dumpty's flight off the wall! Throughout the week the children were involved in engaging and hands on workshops run by the RAF and their partners. We were also lucky enough to be joined by parents who are currently serving in the RAF. These workshops and conversations gave the children an excellent insight into the work that the RAF do, what it means to be an engineer and how STEM is in the world all around us.

During the week the children have built: catapults, planes that can drop supplies, rockets, parachutes, buggies, Lego Robots, bridges and KNEX buggies. The children also designed uniforms, logos, learnt about the RAF's history, riveted pieces of metal together, took part in a military style physical education and made emotive pieces of art work.

It was fantastic to see the children so excited and engaged in science. I was equally impressed by the children's teamwork and leadership skills and resilience when undertaking a new task. We invite you all to join us on 11th July from 1330 to look at our science exhibition in the small hall.
