New Trail Intersection Signs

Last year NYSSA learned that new junction numbers were being assigned by NYS Parks to the trail intersections. Parks ordered these signs and they were send to each club's municipal Sponsors, with a few minor glitches that have been worked out. Some clubs may get right out and place them at each intersection to replace the old junction ID #'s before the season starts, while others will place the new signs along with the old signs so as to allow riders with older maps to be able to see both and find their locations. New signs should be up this season and all mapping projects will be requested to use only the new numbers that Parks will have assigned by then. If you notice any missing junction ID # signs, please contact your local club to alert them.

E-911 Locator Signs on Trails

The Allstate sponsored E-911 (emergency locator) signs are more visible than ever, thanks to more clubs installing them on the trails each year. These signs alert riders to the road cross-ings and junctions that they are at which will have GPS coordinates printed on the signs for any needed trail rescues services. Riders seem to understand what they are there for now that they are more noticed.


TRAIL WATCH on National Grid Lands

As a reminder to all riders, clubs that are using National Grids lands for their snowmobile trails applied for permission through the National Grid Real Estate Offices through a significant process. Years ago, NYSSA set-up a TRAIL WATCH PROGRAM to help protect sensitive facilities along our trails as well as to ask for riders to show RESPECT while on these lands. We ask that all snowmobile riders watch for suspicious activities on the trails and notify authorities if anything out of the ordinary is witnessed.

Zero Alcohol

NYSSA reminds riders that many snowmobilerelated accidents would be prevented if every rider made the smart choice for zero alcohol.

It is recognized that riding a snowmobile is a voluntary activity that may be hazardous. Operating a snowmobile requires peak concentration and reactions at all times.




Tips for Safe Snowmobiling

- Zero alcohol before and during a ride
- Respect landowners' wishes, obey posted signs and stay on the marked trail
- Ride within your ability; operate at a safe and prudent speed at all times
- Stay to the right, share the trail, and yield to groomers
- Be prepared for changing trail and weather conditions
- Obey NYS snowmobiling laws
- Always ride with another snowmobiler

Registration and Membership

This past year NYSSA was able to get the Legislature and Governor to commit another \$5 from the current \$45 registration fee to the trail fund. **\$40 of every club member discounted registration and \$95 of every non discounted registration will be placed in the trail fund beginning October 1, 2016.** So please register your sled after October 1 and ensure the trail fund has adequate resources to care for our 10,500 miles of trail. Unfortunately, the clubs also need to depend on your membership fees to pay for those things the State does not pay for but are necessary for club operations. They also need your membership to set up the trail system now. For most clubs the first state check does not show up until well into 2017.
