Predicting outcomes. More addition through practical applications, beginning simple equations. Let's explore time.</p>
<p>Musical</p> <p>Oranges and Lemons song and game, London Bridge is falling, let's go to the market song, Monster Mash. Listening to music carefully for sounds, learning to count the music and trying to move in time.</p>	<p>Interpersonal</p> <p>Father's Day and what do we love about dad? Let's find our tidying power, how to use our resources correctly, let's help each other complete tasks, how should we act together.</p>
<p>Visual and Spatial</p> <p>Ruler drawings. Let's use food to create pictures and, a virtual tour of London Dungeons. Let's make some scary things for Halloween. Fire! Design a face mask for Halloween.</p>	<p>Bodily - Kinesthetics</p> <p>How do our bodies react to fear and how do we calm ourselves? Face painting. Let's make scary faces in the mirror and take a photo.</p>
<p>Intrapersonal</p> <p>Let's make our own project for Dad. What do I experience when scared and how can I overcome it? What can I say about my dad? Let's learn to lead and listen to others.</p>	<p>Naturalist</p> <p>Where does Halloween originate and how is it celebrated in the UK. Forest animals and a visit to a forest in the UK. What are animals getting ready for and how?</p>
<p>Ideas for activities at home</p> <p>Start reading to children every night to help build listening skills and increase focus and attention.</p>	<p>Parents, please talk about the children's tidying power, talk about times you were scared as a child and how you overcame it. Any trips made. Objects related to the UK brought for Circle time.</p>
